Race Day Timeline

Morning

- 7:00 am Coaches Arrive

Bib & packet pick up on the deck outside the Heather shack at the bottom of the GS race hill (one coach only per team)
***Packets will not be distributed to teams until their respective volunteer positions are filled with volunteer names**
- 7:30 am Coaches meeting on the deck outside the Heather shack at the bottom of the GS race hill
- 8:15 am Gate judges meeting on the deck outside the Heather shack at the bottom of the GS race hill
- 8:15 am Run order substitution deadline
- 8:00 am Chair Opens for Athlete Loading
- 8:15-8:45am **Courses open for inspection**
Per MHSAA rule, all athletes must be off course at 9:00am
Jury observes course inspection
Women's Slalom inspection by in and out Inspection only. (Unless requested by Jury)
Men's GS inspection in and out only. (Unless requested by Jury)
- 9:00am Racer meeting/National Anthem outside the Heather shack at the bottom of the GS race hill
- 9:00am Gate judges in place for Run #1 on GS and slalom hills
- 9:05 am Forerunners for Run #1 Slalom skier left, GS skiers left
- 9:15am First run starts for men and women

Inspection for run #2 opens 5 minutes after completion of 1st run

- Inspection Closes 30 minutes after opening
- Gate judges in place for Run #2 on GS and Slalom hills when inspection closes
- Forerunners for Run #2: Slalom skiers right, GS skiers right

**DQ's will be posted after each flight is completed. DQ cards will be on the deck of the Heather shack until 15 minutes after the completion of each run. Protests must be made within 15 minutes after the completion of each run

Break and Reset after completion of morning race

Afternoon

Scratch deadline 30 minutes after finish of morning session (at Heather shack deck)

Courses open for inspection – 45 minutes after completion of morning session

- Jury observes course inspection (same as above)
- Men's slalom skiers right "In and Out" inspection only, unless specified by Jury
- Women's GS inspection skiers right In and Out inspection only, unless specified by Jury

Inspection closes 30 minutes after course inspection begins

- Gate judges in place for Run #1 on both GS and Slalom hills
- Forerunners Run #1 - Slalom skiers right, GS skiers right

Run #1 Starts 5 minutes after course inspection closes

- Run #1 starts for men Slalom and women GS
- Inspection for run #2 begins 5 minutes after completion of 1st Run

30 minutes after inspection begins

- Inspection Closes
- Gate judges in place for Run #2, both Slalom and GS hills
- Forerunners Run #2: Slalom skiers right, GS skiers right
- Run #2 starts for men and women
