Finals Credentials	All media wishing to cover this event must submit the MHSAA online request form by noor
rinais Greuentiais	March 2. All requests must be submitted in advance by the Sports Editor/Director of
	each outlet wishing to cover the event. Please do not submit credential requests until
	after the Regional round of activity is completed. Those outlets which have been approved
	for passes will be e-mailed pertinent information related to their coverage of the event on
	March 2. MHSAA Finals Passes are good for this event – ID may be required. Outlets with
	MHSAA Finals Passes should submit the online request form to declare their intention to
	cover the event. Media will enter through Gate C beginning at 8 a.m. both days. That
	entrance will close at 7 p.m. Friday and 5 p.m. Saturday. There is no on-site will call at
	Ford Field. Media must pick up credentials at the MHSAA office or request them early
	enough (by emailing Jon Ross at jon@mhsaa.com) to receive them in the mail (if they do
	not have the annual tournament pass). Parking codes will be emailed to approved
	registered media the evening of March 2. No walk-up requests for credentials will be
	honored.
Media Accommodations at Ford Field	Only writers and photographers who are transmitting content continuously throughout the
	meet will be allowed seating at the head table. Wireless internet will be available.
	Working and transmission space is also available in the Lions Interview Room, where
	wireless internet will be available.
	Media may only be on the floor when they have a match in progress. Otherwise, seating
	will be provided on the sidelines for those waiting for an upcoming match. All media must
	be seated on the floor while shooting or observing – standing will not be allowed. Shooting
	in the scorer's table/coaches bench area is prohibited.
	There will be a required photographer's meeting in the Lions Interview Room prior to the
	Final matches (approximately 2:30 p.m.) to review protocols.
	All results will be available online from the wrestling page of the MHSAA Website or on
	TrackWrestling. Printed results will not be available.

Live Streaming Finals Video On MHSAA.tv	All matches will be streamed live on a subscription basis on the MHSAA.tv Website. The stream for all matches prior to the Finals will be shot from the scorer's table, complete with full graphics indicating the wrestlers, score, time, and information about completed and upcoming matches. The stream for the Finals will include manned matside cameras with announcers.
	A \$10.99 pass is available, enabling viewers to watch 30 days of live and on-demand tournament action.
