

FAQ's for Alpine Skiing

2011-12

1. 8D – Workers

Each qualifying team shall provide two workers, ski or hill qualified, for both the morning and afternoon events. This shall be applied to each male and female event (e.g., If the girls' team qualified, the school must supply two people in the morning and two people in the afternoon. If both the boys' team and the girls' team qualified, the school must provide four workers in the morning and four workers in the afternoon).

2. Bibs – New This Year

All Regionals and each Final Tournament will use MHSAA-issued Lycra bibs. Each skier must wear the bib and bib number assigned to them by the host management. AFTER the meet, the individual must return the bib to the host manager. The school is responsible for any bib not returned to the host. A cost of \$25 (payable to the MHSAA) will be charged to the school for each missing bib.

3. Weather Postponements for MHSAA Regional Ski Meets

A. If the snow conditions at a Regional ski site are such that the meet cannot be contested on the regularly scheduled date, the postponed day may be made up at the site or alternate site on the following Friday, Saturday, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday.

B. If the meet is not completed by the Wednesday immediately following the Thursday Regional date, there will be no representatives from that Regional at the Final Meet.

C. Decisions regarding the matter will be made by the Regional Manager in conjunction with the MHSAA staff member responsible for skiing.

4. To be eligible to enter the Regional Ski Meet, the team must enter and ski a minimum of four skiers in each discipline.
