1. SWIMMING ENTRY PROCEDURE – Please read!!
 - a. All entries are due by **12:00 pm** the **Monday** before the state meet
Please Include:
 1. Coaches contact info: Phone number and email address – on Hy-tec
 2. Appropriate MHSAA school name/abbreviation from MHSAA website (all codes are updated for use with Hy-tec.
 3. Grades for all athletes in NUMBER format 9-10-11-12.
 4. Appropriate/verifiable seed time using Hy-tec.
 - d. By **12:00 pm, Tuesday**, state meet hosts will email back confirmation of receipt of entries and an entry report from what they receive.
 - e. Coaches have until **9:00 pm, Tuesday** to reply with any corrections to entry report – LATE OR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE SUBJECT TO \$50 LATE FEE.
 - f. Psych sheet will be posted on MHSAA at **12:00 pm, Wednesday**. **NO CHANGES TO ENTRIES WILL BE ALLOWED AFTER 12:00 PM, WEDNESDAY.**
 - g. Entries/Psych sheets **must** include relay names and alternates.

ENTRIES: All swim and dive entries are due **Monday, November 14th, 2011 by 12 NOON pm.** ALL entries must be in Hy-tec format (meet file available at MHSAA.com), *sent to shortpar5@gmail.com* Please include an emergency phone number and contact information. Make sure to include divers' names and grades who have qualified for Regionals.

REMINDER: Email HY-Tec entries to: shortpar5@gmail.com by MONDAY November 14th 2011 AT 12 NOON pm.

***IMPORTANT: make sure your school's firewall does NOT take the zip file off the email attachment! You will receive a confirmation of your entries by 12 NOON Tuesday, November 15th.** Our entry director will not have access immediately so please be patient. If you have NOT received confirmation by this time contact Shawn Kornoelje.

RULES: M.H.S.A.A. rules will apply according to National Federation (Current Edition). There will be a 10 minute break after the 200 Yard Medley Relay and before the first heat of the 200 Yard Freestyle. There will be a 15 minute break between the last heat of the 50 Yard Freestyle and the first heat of the 100 Yard Butterfly during Prelims.

DIVING:

Diving results & Dive sheets will be emailed directly to the State Meet Director from Regional site. There is no longer a need to fax your dive sheets to the Host site. Changes to dive sheet during the State meet can be done up until 2:30pm, November 18th, 2011. Please see that your entry person (Head Coach) includes Diver in the Hy-tec entry sent on Monday, November 14th, 2011 no matter if they qualify or not. Questions please contact Meet Director.

CONCESSIONS:

WARM-UP & COOL-DOWN:

Swimmers may warm-up/cool-down on the South side of the bulkhead in the lanes provided.

DECK PASSES:

Deck passes will be issued, to all qualifying athletes, by the host and must be visible at all times.

Only two (2) coaches' passes per team will be issued (per MHSAA). No manager pass will be issued for teams with less than 5 qualifiers. Extra coaches or manager passes can be purchased by the head coach only for \$15 per pass at the registration table. Receipts will be provided upon request.

Note: Athlete Deck Passes may not be used for access into the Spectator seating area

AQUATIC CENTER IMPORTANT FACILITY NOTES

Oakland University Athletic Department and Aquatic Center Rules will be enforced at all times.

NO coolers or food brought into the facility. Concessions will be available.

NO video or camera tripods.

NO extension cords or battery chargers.

NO helium balloons.

NO taping of signs or team banners in facility except in designated area only.

NO shaving down of any kind in facility.

NO parking of buses or usage by buses in drop-off area in front of O'rena.

NO entrance into the swimming venue from the Recreation building entrance. **OU students only.**

Parking permitted in all lots on a first come first serve basis. Lot's 26,16,17,18, along with the parking structure are the closest. School is in session on Friday and parking will be limited. People parking in unauthorized areas will be ticketed.

Athletes and coaches only will be allowed to enter through from the "*Participant & Officials*" doors located off the loading dock entrances in back of O'rena.

Team Registration will begin on Friday morning on Level I of the natatorium starting at 9:30 AM.

Participant passes must be visible at all times.

Only two coaches (2) passes per team will be issued (per MHSAA). Extra coaches or manager passes can be purchased for \$15 per pass at the registration table. Receipts will be provided

Bleacher seating will be provided on the pool deck for team use. Teams are responsible to clean up their area before leaving the facility.

No signs, posters, banners, etc. may be posted in the lobby or outside the building, these are considered *neutral sites*.

No balloons permitted in the building.

Noisemakers and **flash photography** are prohibited.

Seating in the upstairs bleachers will be available on a first come first serve basis. Saving seats is NOT allowed. Do NOT sit in the stairways; this is considered a fire hazard.

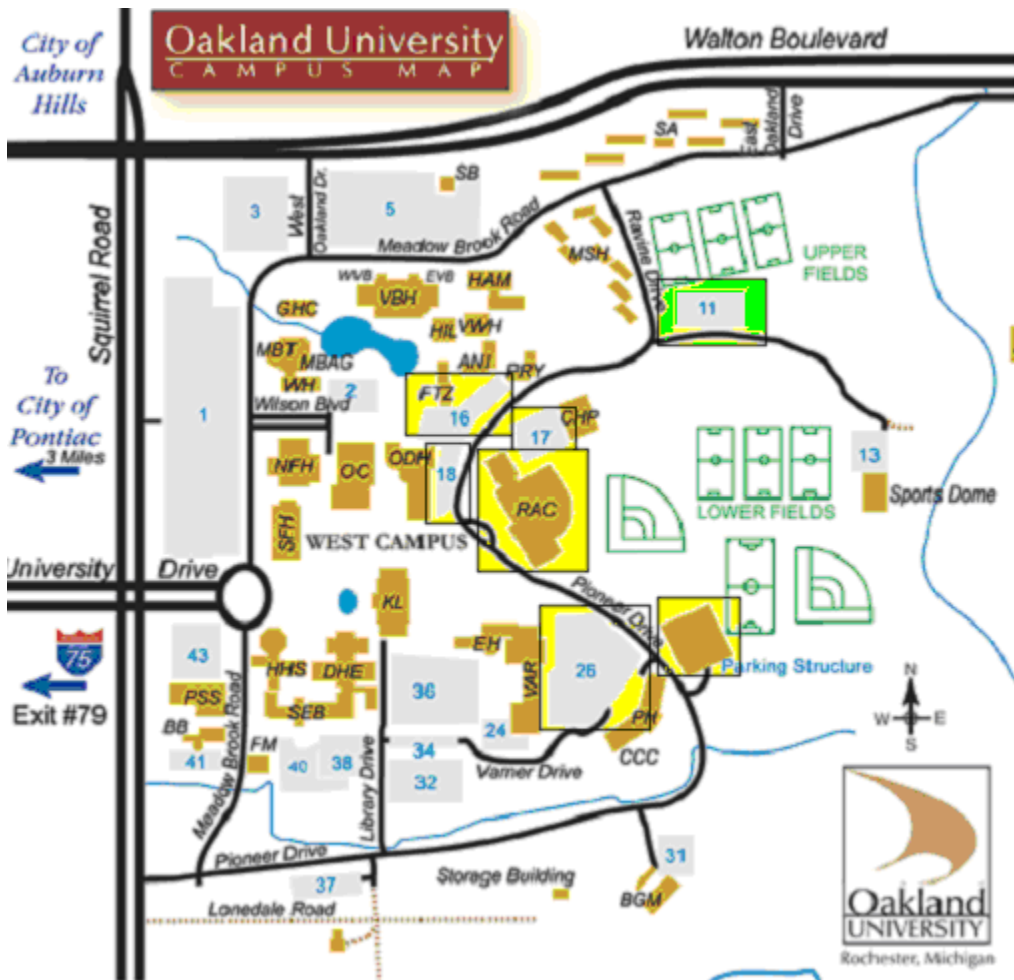
