

FINAL GAME NOTES — These two teams met in the first game of the season at Fowler, with the Eagles taking a 20-7 win. It was the fourth straight year that Frankfort had reached the finals, and the third straight year the Panthers were playing a team from the Central Michigan Athletic Conference. The field goal by C. Koenigsknecht to end the first half was set up by Fowler stopping Frankfort on a fourth down play at own 35 with just over a minute to play. It took six plays for the Eagles to move the ball to the Panther 14 to set up the kick. Fowler scored on its first drive of the third quarter, and its final score was set up following a fumble recovery by B. Sillman.
