<b>Finals Credentials</b>	<p>Outlets with MHSAA Finals Passes DO NOT need to submit a credential request to cover this event – simply present your pass at the gate. Outlets needing to request single-event passes for non-Finals Pass holders must contact Jon Ross at the MHSAA by noon on Feb. 23 at <a href="mailto:jon@mhsaa.com">jon@mhsaa.com</a>. All requests must be submitted in advance by the Sports Editor/Director of each outlet wishing to cover the event. All passes ordered for Will Call pickup may be picked up at the Wings Event Center at Gate 7, located between the main arena and the Zoo/Valley rinks. No walk-up requests for credentials will be honored.</p>
<b>Media Accommodations at Wings Event Center</b>	<p>All media should enter the building through Gate 7 and take the stairs at Section 129 to ice level and beneath the stands to The Coaches Room, which is the Press Room for this event.</p> <p><b>The mats will be elevated, and no media will be allowed on the mats at any time.</b></p> <p>Photographers will be allowed to shoot, and writers will be allowed to observe from a designated location at each mat. Photographers are not allowed in the team bench areas.</p> <p>No interviews will be allowed on the floor except after the Final matches. Media may conduct interviews with coaches and athletes as they exit the ice at the West end of the arena. No formal press conferences will be conducted. All results will be available online from the wrestling page of the MHSAA Website.</p>
