

HIGH SCHOOL and MIDDLE SCHOOL/JUNIOR HIGH BAT RULES

HIGH SCHOOL: All non-wood bats MUST not weigh more than three ounces less than the length of the bat (e.g. a 33-inch long bat cannot be less than 30 ounces) and MUST meet the Batted Ball Coefficient of Restitution (BBCOR) performance standard, and such bats shall be labeled with the BBCOR certification mark.

MIDDLE SCHOOL/JUNIOR HIGH: For games at the middle school level, member school teams may deviate from National Federation rules and use the bat standard currently allowed by Little League Baseball. This bat standard is the certification mark placed on the bat of **USA Baseball**, with this new bat standard effective with the 2018 season. BBCOR bats are also legal at the middle school/junior high level.
