General Notes regarding Region 30-3

Entries: Please make sure you enter only 3 athletes in each event unless each one has hit additional qualifying mark for regionals. Entries are due by 8PM Tuesday May 18th. You must scratch down to 2 athletes on Friday unless all have hit additional qualifying mark.

FAT Conversion: All times must be entered as FAT times to the hundredth (.00) or hand held equivalent adjusted by rounding to the nearest tenth and adding .24.(done by athletic.net)

Example Hand Time = 11.51 Converted FAT Time = 11.84 (11.51 round to tenth is 11.6 add .24 is 11.84)

Coaches Meeting: If necessary we will have a Coaches meeting in the Pole Barn at 12:30pm. We hope to communicate everything well enough that the Coaches meeting is not necessary and teams can just turn in scratch sheets and referees statements.

Athlete Check In/Bull Pen Procedure: We will be using Athletic.Live and uploading heat sheets there and sending emails out. Please communicate this with your athletes. Athletes should check in no later than 3rd Call. If there are scratches beyond the scratch period please communicate these to the Clerk so plans can be made.

Scratches: Field event and prelim scratches will be due to the pole barn at 12:30pm, at the beginning of the coaches meeting. All remaining scratches will be due to the bullpen at 4:30 PM.

Parking: Buses should park in Parking Lot #3 to the north of the concessions building. 3rd Street is the best Street for buses to take to drop off teams. Spectators can park in Parking Lot #1 east of the Track Complex and, if that fills up, space will be available in Parking Lot #4 & #5 to the north of the High School after 3:30 PM. **See attached map.**

Tent/Team Area: Please setup camp/tents on the grass south of the visiting side bleachers and headed around the end of the track towards the Long Jump area, please do not go past the scoreboard though. Tents might also be able to setup behind the home bleachers up against the Softball Field depending on how dry this area is. Please do not setup or play around on the softball or baseball fields. Additional space will be available behind and between the Shot and Discus areas. Please setup Team Camps spaced out from other teams. **See attached map.**

Masks: Masks are required for all participants, coaches and spectators unless the athlete is in active competition.

Emergency Info: In case of severe weather we will follow MHSAA protocol and postpone the meet. All athletes and coaches should go to their buses. If necessary, the High School Gym will be made available.
