The following schools will be participating in the Division I Regional Track Meet to be held at the Negaunee High School Stadium on Thursday, May 19th.

Negaunee, Calumet, Houghton, Kingsford, Westwood

- 1. A scratch meeting will be held at 3:00 p.m. (eastern) at the Miners Dry Locker room.
- 2. **Starting Blocks...**Teams are required to bring their own starting blocks.
- 3. 1/4" Pyramid Spikes will be allowed.
- 4. **High Jump** Marking materials which leave permanent marks on the runway are prohibited. Starting height for the high jump will be boys 5'0" and girls 4'0". The bar will be raised 3" until 3 competitors are left, then 2" thereafter.
- 5. **Pole Vault** Starting height for the pole vault will be boys 9'0" and girls 6'0". The bar will be raised 6" until 3 competitors are left, then 3" thereafter.
- 6. **Long Jump-** Each competitor will have 3 jumps in the preliminaries and the top 5 jumpers will advance to Finals (3 jumps each)
- 7. **Shot Put and Discus** Each competitor will have 3 throws in the preliminaries and the top 5 throwers will advance to Finals (3 throws each). Rubber soled shoes are required. Shot Puts and Discus will be weighted and inspected in the Miners Dry Building prior to the meet. Do not throw the shot put on the football field.
- 8. Scoring will be 5-3-2-1 in all events. Four individuals and 4 relays will qualify for the U.P. Finals.
- 9. There will be no preliminaries in any races. Alleys will be used in events where they are applicable.
- 10. Participants will be seeded by times. Heats will be run from slowest to fastest.
- 11. Timing and Scoring will be conducted by Sam Graci of Superior Timing.
- 12. Medal winners will be announced after each final event, but coaches will pick up all medals at the conclusion of the meet.
- 13. Rain date will be Friday, May 20th at Negaunee.

- 1) All times submitted for the Regional meet must be entered as FAT times
- 2) If the times you are submitting are "handheld", then they must be converted to FAT time before submitting your entries. In order to convert a handheld time to a FAT time, you must do the following: Round the time up to the nearest whole tenth and then add .24
- 3) Example...Handheld time is 12.73. First round "up" to the nearest whole tenth (12.8) and then add .24 so that the time entered for Regionals should be 13.04
