APPROVED INTERNATIONAL STUDENT PROGRAMS FOR 2024-25

(As of 8/21/24)

International students who are required to have either an F-1 or J-1 visa are eligible under the Transfer Regulation for varsity level interscholastic teams only if they have been placed in a member school through an “Approved International Student Program.”

The following programs have been approved by the MHSAA Executive Committee for the 2024-25 school year.

MHSAA Member School Programs (limited to five international students participating or one percent of high school enrollment, whichever is greater):

- Birmingham-Brother Rice High School – Maximum of **six (6)** international students (total of J-1 and F-1 visa students) allowed to participate on varsity level interscholastic teams during the **2024-25** academic year.
- Burton-Genesee Christian High School – Maximum of **five (5)** international students (total of J-1 and F-1 visa students) allowed to participate on varsity level interscholastic teams during the **2024-25** academic year.
- Clarkston-Everest Collegiate High School – Maximum of **five (5)** international students (total of J-1 and F-1 visa students) allowed to participate on varsity level interscholastic teams during the **2024-25** academic year.
- Grand Rapids Christian High School – Maximum of **eight (8)** international students (total of J-1 and F-1 visa students) allowed to participate on varsity level interscholastic teams during the **2024-25** academic year.
- Grand Rapids-NorthPointe Christian High School – Maximum of **five (5)** international students (total of J-1 and F-1 visa students) allowed to participate on varsity level interscholastic teams during the **2024-25** academic year.
- Grand Rapids-West Catholic High School – Maximum of **five (5)** international students (total of J-1 and F-1 visa students) allowed to participate on varsity level interscholastic teams during the **2024-25** academic year.
- Grosse Pointe Woods-University Liggett School – Maximum of **five (5)** international students (total of J-1 and F-1 visa students) allowed to participate on varsity level interscholastic teams during the **2024-25** academic year.
- Holland Christian High School – Maximum of **seven (7)** international students (total of J-1 and F-1 visa students) allowed to participate on varsity level interscholastic teams during the **2024-25** academic year.
- Jenison High School (Jenison International Academy) – Maximum of **sixteen (16)** international students (total of J-1 and F-1 visa students) allowed to participate on varsity level interscholastic teams during the **2024-25** academic year.
- Midland-Calvary Baptist High School – Maximum of **five (5)** international students (total of J-1 and F-1 visa students) allowed to participate on varsity level interscholastic teams during the **2024-25** academic year.
- Muskegon-West Michigan Christian High School – Maximum of **five (5)** international students (total of J-1 and F-1 visa students) allowed to participate on varsity level interscholastic teams during the **2024-25** academic year.
- Pannonia Christian Educational Exchange – Maximum of **five (5)** international students (total of J-1 and F-1 visa students) allowed to participate on varsity level interscholastic teams during the **2024-25** academic year.
- St. Joseph-Michigan Lutheran High School – Maximum of **five (5)** international students (total of J-1 and F-1 visa students) allowed to participate on varsity level interscholastic teams during the **2024-25** academic year.
- Sterling Heights-Parkway Christian High School – Maximum of **five (5)** international students (total of J-1 and F-1 visa students) allowed to participate on varsity level interscholastic teams during the **2024-25** academic year.
