Tournament Rules

MHSAA tournament rules: See the MHSAA Bowling site for boys and girls Tournament Participants and Manager Information (<u>Boys Bowling | Michigan High School Athletic Association</u>) as well as the MHSAA 2022-23 Bowling Coaches Manual. USBC rules will govern this event.

Bowling Ball Limits

Participants shall be limited to a maximum of FIVE bowling balls in the bowling center, and two balls in the bowler's area with one ball allowed on the ball return at a time. All other bowling balls and bags are to be in the paddock area. This is not a sanctioned USBC event. A bowler may not leave the center to get other balls during competition. Equipment changes will be allowed during competition. Bowling balls must be on the USBC approved ball list (BOWL.com | Approved Ball List) to be used in MHSAA competition.

Lineage

Lineage is \$3.00 per game. The *Team event* consists of 18 games per team or 36 games per school. For the Singles competition, a full squad of 6 individuals bowling 6 games results in 36 games per school. So a school with a full squad will bowl a total of 54 games or 108 games per school. Please see the example below.

Boys Varsity

8 baker games = 8 games 2 team games x 5 bowlers = 10 games

6 bowlers x 6 games = 36 games Total of 54 games

Girls Varsity

8 baker games = 8 games 2 team games x 5 bowlers = 10 games

6 bowlers x 6 games = 36 games Total of 54 games

Therefore, a school with boys and girls varsity would bowl a total of 108 games @ \$3.00 per game for a total of \$324.00. If sending in less than 6 bowlers for the singles event, the cost could be adjusted. (example: 1 bowler x 6 games x \$3.00/game equals \$18.00 which may be deducted accordingly.

Admission

Per MHSAA regulation, admission will be handled through GoFan online ticketing at a cost of <u>\$7.00</u> <u>admission</u> for all spectators (adults, students and children). Tickets may be purchased in advance at <u>www.gofan.co</u>. Please share this information with your parents and spectators to expedite entrance at the tournament. Similar to all MHSAA tournaments, we have included 4 administrators' passes for your school administrator, board member and/or coaches spouses.

Format

TEAM format will consist of eight (8) bakers, alternating lanes for baker games. Rotate lanes after each baker set and regular game - total pin count. On **Saturday**, Singles format will consist of six (6) individual games, rotating after each game - total pin count.

In the event of a tie:

Team- One Baker set (2 games), if still tied then a 6-10th frame Baker format roll-off repeated until tie is broken.

Singles - One regular game, if still tied then a 9 - 10th frame roll-off repeated until the tie is broken.

Tournament - Practice

There will be fifteen (15) minutes for the TEAM on Friday. You will receive seven and one half (7 1/2) minutes on each lane. There will be ten (10) minutes of practice prior to the start of the SINGLES on Saturday.







Pre - Tournament Practice

Oak Lanes will schedule dates in which they will put out the tournament shot for any team wishing to come in and practice. Coaches may call the Center to determine dates and times for tournament practice.

Lane Conditions

The event will be bowled using the Kegel "Phantom" pattern. The lanes will be conditioned before every squad.

Lane Assignment

The Regional Manager will make lane assignments by random draw prior to the tournament. Lane assignments will be posted at check in and a copy given out at the coaches meeting.

Lane Rotation

Team event teams: Odd lanes move left and even lanes right. Singles: All rotate right after each game.

Dress Code

Boys- Stacks are required. Jeans, cutoffs, shorts, sweatpants or warm-up pants will NOT be allowed. A collared shirt or mock turtleneck will be required. T-Shirts will not be allowed.

Girls-Slacks, shorts, or skirts will be allowed. Skirts must reach the top of the knee and shorts shall be an appropriate length. Jeans, cutoffs, sweatpants or warm-up pants will NOT be allowed. Yoga Pants may NOT be worn. A collared shirt or mock turtleneck will be required. T-shirts will not be allowed, however mock turtle neck shirts allowed for both and limited jewelry. No Coaches or participants may wear hats, caps, or any other headgear.

Coaching Restrictions

Per MHSAA 2 school approved coaches per gender will be allowed in the bowlers' area during competition. Additional coaches may be seated directly behind the lanes at the table. Coaches are not allowed on the approaches. Additional coaches must be in the spectator area. Coaching is allowed only between frames. Coaches must wear their designated tournament identification badge during competition. Coaches must be in school uniform and display tournament identification lanyards.

Sportsmanship

Good sportsmanship for players and coaches is a must. Taunting, profanity, and intimidating conduct are not allowed. All MHSAA regulations regarding sportsmanship and disqualifying penalties as stated in Regulation IV, Section 3 will be followed. Players will not be allowed to approach to congratulate or celebrate the accomplishments of a fellow team member during bowling. Bowlers will not be allowed to enter an adjacent approach to celebrate or "run out" their delivery. Bowlers shall observe traditional bowling courtesy for bowlers on adjacent lanes. Please inform your spectator of the following sportsmanship rules. No noise makers are allowed. No spectators allowed in the bowler's area. No flash cameras are allowed. Cheers should be positive.

Alcohol and Tobacco

No alcohol or tobacco is allowed in the bowling and spectators area during a MHSAA contest.







Food

No outside food or drink is to be brought in the Bowling Center. Oak Lanes has numerous eating options available.

Paddock:

At check in, bowlers will be informed of the paddock area. Storage of bowling balls is NOT available. The Bowling Center, MHSAA or host school is NOT RESPONSIBLE for lost or stolen items. Do not leave valuables, i.e. phones, iPad, iPhone etc. in the paddock area.

In settling all disputes, the tournament directors will make all final decisions.
