Bowling Fees The cost for bowling in Region 21 is \$152.50 per team. Schools with boys and girls teams will pay \$303.00.

All fees are to be made payable to Jax 60.

Checks MUST be presented by a coach at check in on the day of event.

NO EXCEPTIONS

Teams that do not pay the first morning of competition, will not compete.

DO NOT mail payment to the bowling center.



Rosters And Master Eligibility Lists

Spectators and Admission

The MHSAA will use digital ticketing (GoFan) at all Regional sites. You will receive a code for your school. Ticket price will be \$7.00 per spectator per day.

Food or Beverages

No outside food or beverages are allowed into the bowling center. Jax 60 has a bar that serves food.

Valuables

Please do not bring in any of your valuables (iPads, iPods, etc.) to the bowling center. The MHSAA, Jax 60, or Hanover-Horton High School cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items.

Regional Format

TEAMS

- Teams will have up to seven bowlers per team. Five bowlers will bowl in the team event.
- All five starting bowlers may be substituted for in any given game. If a substitute is injured, they may be replaced by an eligible substitute.
- Teams will bowl six baker games and three regular games.
- Tiebreaker will be one Baker set (2 games), if still tied a 6-10 frame Baker roll-off (s) until a winner is determined.
- Top three teams in the Regional will move on to the State Finals.

SINGLES

- Singles event will have six bowlers on each team.
- Bowlers will bowl six regular games.
- Tiebreaker will be one regular game, if still tied a 9-10 frame roll-off(s) until a winner is determined;
- Top ten bowlers in the Regional will move on to the State Finals.



Regional Bowling Ball limits

Participants shall be limited to a **maximum of FIVE bowling balls in the bowling center**, and **two balls in the bowler's area**. Additional bowling balls should be kept in the assigned equipment area. A bowler may not leave the center to get other balls during competition. Equipment changes will be allowed during competition. Bowling balls must be on the USBC approved ball list to be used in MHSAA competition. Players may not alter the surface of the ball with abrasives or apply cleaner after competition begins.

Coach limits

Two coaches per gender will be allowed in the bowlers' area during competition. Coaches are not allowed on the approaches. Additional coaches/scorekeepers are to be in the spectator area. Coaching is allowed only between frames.

Uniform/Dress Code

Boys – Slacks and a collared shirt or mock turtleneck are required.

Girls – Slacks, shorts or skirt with a collared shirt or mock turtleneck are required. Skirts must reach the top of the knee and shorts shall be an appropriate length. No yoga pants or leggings.

All – **No jeans, cutoffs, sweatpants or warm-up pants. No hats, caps or any type of headgear are allowed.**

Coaches must also adhere to the MHSAA uniform/dress code regulations.

Practice

Bowlers may practice at Jax 60 prior to the MHSAA Regional dates during normal open bowling time at normal rates. Please contact the bowling alley to schedule practice. No practice is allowed on days of MHSAA competition.

LATE ARRIVALS

Teams and/or individuals who do not arrive for the scheduled start time will receive a score of zero for each frame missed. Managers may delay the start of an event for legitimate travel problems (weather, accident) if contacted in advance by the school or coach.

Live Streaming

Teams participating in MHSAA Tournaments **are prohibited from streaming live video** of any portion of an event over the Internet - including using social media platforms like YouTube and Facebook – or any other method. Likewise, individual spectators are also prohibited from streaming video through any means during the MHSAA tournament.
