Entry Procedures:

Deadline for submitting roster and Master Eligibility lists is **Feb. 2, 2024**. Entry materials should be sent via e-mail to Mason Athletic Director Connor Thomas - thomasc@masonk12.net - or Administrative Assistant Peggy Wasner - wassnerp@masonk12.net

Rosters for the Singles event (Wednesday) are limited to a maximum of six bowlers for each of the boys and girls school entries. Team event (Thursday) consists of a maximum of 7 bowlers for each boys and girls team with 5 constituting a team starting lineup. Roster forms can be found on the MHSAA website.

Lane Fees - Fees must be paid before bowling each day. Checks should be made out to Royal Scot Lanes (singles) and City Limit Lanes (team) DO NOT SEND PAYMENT TO MASON HS - bring payment with you at time of check-in.

Singles Lane Fees – (Feb. 21, Royal Scot) - Fees are \$3.00 per line. For singles, a full entry (6 bowlers) will be \$108.00 for each gender - (\$3.00 X 6 bowlers X 6 games each).

Team Lane Fees – (Feb. 22, City Limits Lanes, Mason) – Fees are \$2.50 per line. Each gender will be \$45.00 (\$2.50 X 8 baker games, \$25 X 2 regular games). For a school with both a boys and girls team, and a full complement of 6 boys and 6 girls singles entries, the total is \$90.00 for team (check to City Limits) and \$216.00 for singles (check to Royal Scot).

Format:

Singles Event (Wednesday) - 6 games, rotate lanes after each game.

Team Event (Thursday) - 8 baker games, followed by 2 regular games.

Rotate lanes after each baker pair and each regular game.

Total pins (scratch) will determine final placement. Top two teams and top seven singles advance to the MHSAA State Finals in each gender. Ties will be broken to determine 1st place and final qualifying position. Lane assignments will be drawn randomly when all entries are received and processed.

Oil Pattern - The Regional lane condition will be the Kegel “Phantom 2” pattern, details are available on the MHSAA Web bowling pages.

Coaching - Up to two coaches per gender will be allowed free admission. There can only be **two** coaches allowed in the bowling area during competition. Coaches are expected to follow the dress code and exemplify proper sportsmanship. Coaches are not allowed on the approaches and can coach between frames.

Paddock Area – At Royal Scot Lanes the lounge area will be used. At City Limits Lanes in Mason, we will use the area to the left of the counter for the paddock.

Line-up Changes/Substitutions - Line-up or roster changes will be allowed at check-in. Replacement bowlers must be on the Master Eligibility List (can be updated before Feb. 21). The MHSAA substitution rule will be followed.

Admission/Spectators - There will be a \$7 admission charge for all spectators purchased only in advance through Go-Fan. Please submit names for the pass list to the Mason HS athletic department.

All MHSAA regulations regarding dress code, equipment, sportsmanship, etc. will apply as specified in the Participating Schools Tournament Information available at mhsaa.com
