

## Girls Competitive Cheer Finals - Ticket FAQs for Fans

- **How do fans purchase tickets from their school's ticket block?**
  - Fans need to contact their school's ticket representative and provide the school with the fan's email address and payment.
- **How long do fans have to purchase ticket(s) from the school's ticket block?**
  - All ticket transfers/sales for each school's ticket block must be completed by **Thursday, February 27, 2025, at 10:00 AM.**
  - Any tickets not transferred by the deadline will be released for public sale online.
- **When are tickets available for public sale outside of the school's ticket block?**
  - Tickets for the general public will be available for purchase starting Monday, February 24, at 10:00 AM.

  - Any tickets from the school blocks that are not transferred by the Thursday, February 27, 10:00 AM deadline will be released for public sale online.
- **How do fans accept tickets once they are transferred from the school?**
  - Once a ticket is transferred, the recipient will receive a text message or email with a link to accept their ticket.
  - A ticket is not valid for entry until the recipient accepts it.
  - Tickets must be added to Apple Wallet or Google Wallet for entry. (To save tickets, open them on a mobile device and select the Add to Wallet option.)
- **Can fans print tickets for the Girls Competitive Cheer Finals?**
  - No, all tickets are digital and must be saved to your mobile wallet to be redeemed.
- **What do fans need to show to enter the Girls Competitive Cheer Finals?**
  - Fans must present their digital ticket saved in their mobile device's wallet for entry.
- **How much do tickets cost?**
  - Tickets are \$13, which includes parking.
- **How many tickets will my school receive?**
  - Each school will receive 150 tickets. These tickets will be seated together in one block.
- **Is accessible/handicap seating available?**
  - Yes, accessible/handicap seating is available in Sections 104 and 106.
    - Spectators requiring accessible seating should purchase tickets either from their school's ticket block or from the general public sale.
    - After purchasing, email [paige@mhsaa.com](mailto:paige@mhsaa.com) with the name(s) and number of wheelchair-accessible spaces and companion seats needed. Reserved seating will be designated in advance.
    - Each wheelchair-accessible space allows for one companion seat, per ADA guidelines. Additional companions may be seated nearby, subject to availability.
    - A limited number of accessible seats will be available for purchase on-site, but these are first-come, first-served. Advance reservations are strongly recommended.
