Nov. 7-8	11-Player District Finals at 64 sites School with higher regular-season playoff average hosts.
Nov. 14-15	11-Player Regional Finals at 32 sites School with higher regular-season playoff average hosts.
Nov. 22	11-Player Semifinals at 16 sites. Neutral sites will be selected by the MHSAA.

11-Player Finals Parking @ Ford Field	Parking will be available in Ford Field lots east and north of the stadium. There will be an \$8 charge for each car. A parking map can be found on the Football Page of the MHSAA Website. Other lots in the vicinity of Ford Field may charge different rates. Media parking will be available, with specific lots to be announced closer to the event.
District/Regional/Semifinal Media Credentials	Media wishing to cover levels of these tournaments must contact the tournament manager at the host site. MHSAA Tournament Media Pass holders should make a courtesy call to the sites where they wish to send reporters.
11-Player Finals Media Credentials	All media wishing to cover this event must submit the MHSAA online request form by Noon on Tuesday, Nov. 25 . <u>All media must register</u> to cover this event; outlets with MHSAA Tournament Media Passes should submit the online request form to declare their intention to cover the event and to reserve seating, if necessary, on press row. The Gate C entrance (corner nearest Tiger Garage) is the designated gate for media entry. No walk-up requests for credentials will be honored. Approved media will be emailed a QR code for parking.
Broadcasters Please Note	Permission to distribute audio or video of Playoff games must be secured from the MHSAA Office in advance, and any applicable rights fees must be paid in advance. Video rights are prioritized as follows: 1. The MHSAA or its designees (NFHS Network-Exclusive Origination); 2. Home team outlet; 3. Visiting team outlet; 4. Other outlets if a game is still available. Only one video origination is allowed per site. The outlets in Nos. 2 through 4 granted the video rights must provide a split feed to other outlets. The outlet taking the split feed is still subject to applicable rights fees.



	<p>Audio broadcasts are limited to two credentials. Site managers may, upon request and if space allows, grant a third credential.</p> <p>Audio rights are prioritized as follows: If space restricts the number of originating outlets, tournament management must provide space for at least one outlet for each participating school, based on the input of the administration of each participating school. It is not based on which outlet applies first to cover a game.</p> <p>Consult the MHSAA Multimedia Regulations for complete details, including a schedule of rights fees.</p>
All Media Outlets Please Note – No Live Game Action Streaming	<p>MHSAA Multimedia Regulations addressing the distribution of live video at all tournaments at all levels also pertain to the streaming of live video on social media platforms, such as Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and YouTube. The streaming of live highlights of a game in progress is prohibited. Live streaming is allowed during pregame, halftime and postgame activities. All applicable rights fees and use limitations shall prevail.</p>
Finals Television On NFHS Network	<p>The NFHS Network will show all eight 11-Player Finals, streamed on the NFHS Network website. Monthly and annual subscriptions are available. Visit MHSAA.tv to register and watch.</p>
Live Semifinal Playoff Video	<p>MHSAA.tv will stream live video of multiple Semifinal playoff games on Nov. 22 on a subscription basis.</p>
Finals Game Audio on MHSAANetwork.com	<p>The MHSAA Network will originate live audio of all Finals games. Stations interested in picking up the feed should contact Jon Ross at the MHSAA. All games will be available on the Internet on the MHSAA Network Website – MHSAANetwork.com, where they will be archived for on-demand listening and available for download as podcasts for \$4.99.</p>
Finals Internet Access Information	<p>Wi-Fi internet access will be available in the press box and photo work area at Ford Field. Media should secure their own hot spots or another internet source if concerned with signal strength.</p>
Sunday Selection Show on NFHS Network	<p>The annual “Sunday Selection Show” will be broadcast on the NFHS Network at 5 p.m. Oct. 26. Full brackets for all eight divisions of 11-player and both divisions of 8-player playoffs will be released. No subscription is required to watch the selection show.</p>
MHSAA Website Coverage	<p>Qualifiers and pairings will be posted at the conclusion of the “Sunday Selection Show” on Oct. 26. Game dates and times will be posted on Oct. 27 at noon and 4:30 p.m. Results will be posted throughout the playoffs. 11-Player Finals game notes will be posted on Nov. 25. Finals game statistics will be posted shortly after the completion of each contest.</p>
