	each outlet wishing to cover the event. Please do not submit credential requests until
	after the Regional round of activity is completed. Those outlets which have been approved
	for passes will be e-mailed pertinent information related to their coverage of the event Feb.

	MHSAA Finals Passes should submit the online request form to declare their intention to
	cover the event. Media will enter through Gate C beginning at 8 a.m. both days. That

Live Streaming Finals Video On MHSAA.tv	All matches will be streamed live on a subscription basis on the MHSAA.tv Website. The stream for all matches prior to the Finals will be shot from the scorer's table, complete with full graphics indicating the wrestlers, score, time, and information about completed and upcoming matches. The stream for the Finals will include manned matside cameras with announcers.
	An \$11.99 pass is available, enabling viewers to watch 30 days of live and on-demand tournament action.
