Semifinal/Finals Credentials	MHSAA Finals passes are good for this event. Parking in Lot 67 is accessible with a media credential. Media who do not have a pass must email Jon Ross (jon@mhsaa.com) by noon June 11 and those passes will be available for pickup at the MHSAA Office from 8 a.m.-4 p.m. June 12 and 13.
Media Accommodations	Wireless Internet service will be available at all three stadiums at Old College Field. Press boxes close one hour after the completion of the final game at that respective stadium. Media may move and continue working at the baseball press box until it closes.
MHSAA Website Coverage	Pairings & results begin with the District level of play. Box scores will be posted for Semifinal and Final games.
