<b>Home Team Bracketing for Districts</b>	Some District tournament sites may exercise the option to play games according to the bracket draw – a non-traditional draw. In a non-traditional draw, the home team – the top line of the bracket – may host a game instead of the designated tournament host.

<b>Tickets</b>	Districts – \$7 Regionals – \$9 Quarterfinals – \$10 Semifinals & Finals – \$14/session (2 games) and includes parking. District, Regional and Quarterfinal tickets will be sold exclusively through GoFan at <a href="https://gofan.co/">https://gofan.co/</a> . Semifinal and Final tickets will be sold by the Breslin Center ticket office. All Semifinals and Finals tickets are general admission.
<b>District/Regional/Quarterfinal Media Credentials</b>	Media wishing to cover levels of these tournaments must contact the tournament manager at the host site in advance. DO NOT CALL THE MHSAA OFFICE.
<b>Broadcasters Please Note</b>	Media outlets wishing to originate MHSAA Tournament games at all levels must receive approval from the MHSAA Office in advance of the games they wish to cover. Broadcast Applications must be made using the online application form – you must register with the MHSAA Office to be able to apply – contact Jon Ross at <a href="mailto:jon@mhsaa.com">jon@mhsaa.com</a> for more information. Audio originations are limited to two seats at all tournament centers. <b>IMPORTANT!! – Any game being streamed on the NFHS Network is not available for local origination (video).</b>
<b>Semifinals/Finals Media Credentials</b>	All media wishing to cover this event must submit the MHSAA online request form ( <a href="https://www.mhsaa.com/live/media-credentials">https://www.mhsaa.com/live/media-credentials</a> ) by noon on March 11. <b>All requests must be submitted in advance by the Sports Editor/Director of each outlet wishing to cover the event.</b> Please do not submit credential requests until after the Regional round of play is completed. Those outlets which have been approved for passes will be e-mailed pertinent information related to their coverage of the event the evening of March 11. Outlets with MHSAA Media Tournament Passes must submit the online request form to declare their intention to cover the event, and to reserve seating, if necessary, on press row. MHSAA Media Tournament Passes are good for parking at the Breslin Center. Press Will Call and mandatory check-in and entrance is at the Accountability Door directly west of the south spectator entrance to Breslin Center. No walk-up requests for credentials will be honored.
<b>Live Streaming Video on NFHS Network</b>	Most District, Regional and all Quarterfinal, Semifinal and Final games will be streamed live on a subscription basis on the NFHS Network website at <a href="https://www.nfhsnetwork.com/associations/mhsaa-mi">https://www.nfhsnetwork.com/associations/mhsaa-mi</a> . A \$13.99 pass is available, enabling viewers to watch 30 days of live and on-demand tournament action.
<b>MHSAA Network Semifinals/Finals Radio Coverage</b>	MHSAA Championship Radio Network. Nearly 60 stations will air the championship games across the state. Semifinal/Final games also will be broadcast on the Internet at <a href="http://www.mhsaanetwork.com">www.mhsaanetwork.com</a> .
<b>Media Accommodations at Breslin Center</b>	Working reporters will be assigned seats on press row.



	<p>Photographers may shoot from the Breslin Center floor. No photographers are allowed at the press tables. No outlet may have more than two photographers shooting a game at any time. Photographers are allowed on the playing surface only at the completion of each championship game for awards. No pregame floor access is allowed.</p> <p>Interview/working press areas will be set up for photographers and writers to edit/write and transmit behind and below the north bleachers. Coaches and players will be brought out after a brief cooling-off period.</p> <p><b><u>No locker room access will be allowed to reporters or photographers – teams may not make exceptions.</u></b> Reporters wishing to do pregame interviews must make arrangements with coaches in advance of the event and do so in an area away from the locker rooms.</p> <p>No dedicated phone line service will be available. Radio stations should plan to bring hot spots if the Breslin wireless signal will not be sufficient.</p>
<b>Semifinals/Finals TV Live Shots</b>	<b>ARRANGEMENTS MUST BE MADE IN ADVANCE FOR LIVE SHOTS REQUIRING A SATELLITE UNIT!</b> Call Jon Ross at the MHSAA in advance of the Semifinals/Finals to make arrangements.
