Finals Credentials	Outlets with MHSAA Finals Passes DO NOT need to submit a credential request to cover this event – simply present your pass at the gate. Outlets needing to request single-event passes for non-Finals Pass holders must contact Jon Ross at the MHSAA by noon on March 3 at jon@mhsaa.com . Please do not submit credential requests until after the Regional round of play is completed. All passes ordered for Will Call pickup may be picked up in the Press Box at USA Hockey Arena. No walk-up requests for credentials will be honored. Media are on their own for parking at USA Hockey Arena.
Media Accommodations at USA Hockey Arena	Access to the working press side of the press box is limited to writers covering a game in progress and radio stations broadcasting that game. No photographers are allowed in the working side of the press box. Wireless internet service will be available. A room located adjacent to the team locker rooms will be set up for photographers and writers to edit/write and transmit. Wireless internet service will be available. It is also the location for postgame interviews. Coaches and players will be brought out after a brief cooling-off period. <u>No locker room access will be allowed for reporters or photographers – teams may not make exceptions.</u> Reporters wishing to do pregame interviews must make arrangements with coaches in advance of the event and do so in an area away from the locker rooms. No photographers will be allowed on the ice following any Semifinal game, and for the Finals, no photographers will be allowed on the ice until the awards ceremony is about to begin.
Live Streaming Video on NFHS Network	The Semifinals and Finals will be streamed live on a subscription basis on the NFHS Network website at https://www.nfhsnetwork.com/associations/mhsaa-mi . A \$13.99 pass is available, enabling viewers to watch 30 days of live and on-demand tournament action.
