Finals	<p>March 3-4 Division 1 – Thunderbowl Lanes, Allen Park Division 2 – Century Bowl, Waterford Division 3 – Jax 60, Jackson Division 4 – M-66 Bowl, Battle Creek Competition begins at 8:25 a.m. both days.</p>
Tournament Format	<p>In Regional Team competition, all teams will bowl two regular games and eight Baker games, and total pinfall will determine team score. In Regional Singles competition, all entrants will bowl six regular games with total pinfall determining score. From each Regional, the top three teams will advance to the MHSAA Team Finals. The top 10 individuals from singles competition will advance to the MHSAA Singles Finals.</p> <p>At the Finals, there will be an 18-team field in each of four divisions for boys and girls. Each team will take part in a 10-game qualifying round of eight Baker games and two regular games to determine the eight teams that will advance to bracket play. The Quarterfinal, Semifinal and Final matches will consist of one regular game and two Baker games. For Singles competition, there will be a field of 60 bowlers in each of four divisions for boys and girls. Each individual will bowl a six-game qualifying block, with the top 16 total pinfall scorers advancing to match play.</p>
