<b>Tickets</b>	Districts – \$7 Regionals – \$9 Semifinals – \$10 Finals – \$11 per day for all sports on site (soccer, baseball & softball). District Quarterfinal and District Semifinal tickets will be sold at the door. Tickets beginning with District Finals will be sold exclusively via GoFan at <a href="http://GoFan.co">GoFan.co</a> .
<b>Finals Credentials</b>	MHSAA Finals passes are good for this event. Parking in Lot 67 is accessible with a media credential. Media who do not have a pass must email Jon Ross ( <a href="mailto:jon@mhsaa.com">jon@mhsaa.com</a> ) by noon June 13 and those passes will be available for pickup at the MHSAA Office from 8 a.m.-4 p.m. June 14.
<b>Media Accommodations</b>	Wireless Internet service will be available at all three stadiums. Press boxes close one hour after the completion of the final game at that respective stadium. Media may move and continue working at the baseball press box until it closes.
<b>MHSAA Website Coverage</b>	Pairings and results begin with the District level of play. Box scores will be posted from Finals games.
<b>Live Streaming Finals Video on MHSAA.tv</b>	The MHSAA.tv Website will stream live video of all Finals games on a subscription basis. An \$11.99 pass is good for 30 days of viewing live content on the NFHS Network. The video will be archived for on-demand viewing.
<b>All Media Outlets Please Note – No Live Game Action Streaming</b>	MHSAA Multimedia Regulations addressing the distribution of live video at all tournaments at all levels also pertain to the streaming of live video on social media platforms such as Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and YouTube. The streaming of live highlights of a game in progress is prohibited. Live streaming is allowed during pregame, halftime and postgame activities. All applicable rights fees and use limitations shall prevail.
