

Registered Assigner Grievance Report

The form must be completed in its entirety, must include a letter of grievance explaining the reason(s) for the submission, the "Standard" number and clause (or MHSAA Handbook Regulation) that is believed to be in violation, and must include all documented evidence. Once submitted, no further evidence or written testimony will be accepted in support of the claim. If the issue is not related to the 'Professional Conduct Standards for Assigners' in the Guidebook (or MHSAA Handbook Regulations), we encourage you to first attempt to resolve the issue through the assigner, officials' association, or with schools and conferences/leagues. This form should be submitted only as a last resort and after all other avenues have been exhausted in trying to resolve the grievance between the complainant and the assigner.

NOTE: This is not an anonymous claim. The assigner shall be allowed to answer the claim made against him/her and maybe afforded a copy of the evidence and testimony to support that claim.
