Jan. 11, 2022 -- Held Ball or Traveling? Let's try a basketball play today. The offensive player jumps in an effort to either take a shot or make a pass. The defensive player reaches out and is able to place their hands on the ball to keep the offensive player from releasing it, and the offensive player returns to the floor with the ball. You Make The Call? There was no contact, so there is no foul. Is it a traveling violation, or is it a held ball with the ball going to the team with the possession arrow in its favor? Some old-timers out there might remember that up until about 1990, a traveling violation would have been called on this play. But the rules now call for a held ball in the situation, with the possession arrow, which had just been introduced 5 years earlier in 1985, prevailing.
