- 1. Which of the following player equipment is considered illegal? (4-1-2)
  - A. Medical equipment such as an insulin pump or cochlear implant which has been covered/securely attached.
  - B. Sweatbands or neoprene sleeve worn on the forearm.
  - C. A hard cast or brace on the hand/lower forearm, covered with half-inch foam.

- 2. Which of the following equipment must be padded? (3-1-3)
  - A. Standards

- 3. Which of the following are examples of legal uniform numbers? (4-2-4c)
