FINAL GAME NOTES — Ida set a finals game record with an 11-hit attack, including a two-run double by senior shortstop Amy Wilson in the sixth inning, to claim the Class C championship, defending Grandville Calvin Christian, 5-2. Ida lost to Calvin Christian in the 1993 finals, 5-2 in nine innings, and in the 1988 finals, 8-0. Wilson's double in the sixth added insurance runs for Ida, which broke a 2-2 tie in the fourth inning when pinch runner Julie Root scored on a sacrifice bunt by senior first baseman Christine Vogelgesang. Sarah Plasman of Calvin Christian tied an all-class final games record with two stolen bases. It was Ida's second championship in four trips to the final game.

FINAL GAME NOTES — Sophomore pitcher Nicole Vernier scored from third on a wild pitch with two outs in the bottom of the sixth inning and then retired the side in order in the seventh as Marine City Cardinal Mooney won the Class D title, defeating Ottawa Lake-Whiteford, 5-4. Whiteford took a 4-3 lead into the sixth inning. A single by junior designated hitter Karrie Bulski drove in senior right fielder Becky Schafer with the tying run, and put Vernier, who had earlier singled, on third to set up the winning scoring play. It was Cardinal Mooney's first title in any sport.
