

FINAL GAME NOTES — Jenison earned its sixth MHSAA Class A softball championship, beating White Lake-Lakeland in the title game, 4-0. Senior catcher DeHoop was the hitting star for the 35-4 Wildcats, with three hits and three runs batted in, tieing a record for hits in a Class A finale. Martin and VanLangevelde each added a pair of hits as part of Jenison's 10-hit attack.

VanLangevelde scattered five hits in posting the team's 21st shutout of the season. Jenison gave up seven runs in eight tournament games during its 1995 title run. Lakeland, finishing its season with a 29-12 record, got two of its five hits from sophomore catcher Povlitz. Jenison bunched its scoring in innings three and four off losing pitcher Dwyer, getting two runs in each frame. DeHoop started the Wildcat scoring with an RBI single in the third, and completed the run production with a two-run single with her next at-bat. Jenison was the only team to repeat as a champion in this year's MHSAA baseball/softball tournament series.

FINAL GAME NOTES — Stevensville Lakeshore completed a near-perfect softball season with a near-perfect 4-1 win over Wyoming Rogers in the MMSAA Class B championship. Lakeshore yielded one run in its final three tournament games to finish with the Class B title and a 43-1 record. Rogers completes its season with a 31-2 standard. Lakeshore scored once in the first and plated the eventual winning run in the third. Rogers came back with a run in the fourth before the Lancers added a pair of insurance runs in the fifth. Lippert and Berry each had a pair of runs batted in for the winners. Lippert, Berry and Erin Phelan combined for six of the team's eight hits. O'Malley was the top hitter for Rogers with three hits to tie a Class B final game record, while Dani Cook and Angie Peuler each had a pair of safeties. It was the first appearance for both teams in the title game.
