



MHSAA Handbook, Regulation I, Section 11

Penalty Summary

Students:

A student violating this Section **shall be ineligible for interscholastic competition for a period of not less than the next 90 scheduled school days after the date of the student's last violation**, except that a student violating Interpretation 129 may not apply for reinstatement until the equivalent of one full school year of enrollment has elapsed following the date of his or her last violation. (Also see Interpretation 154.)

154. A student or school may remedy a violation of this Section (except Interpretation 129) by promptly reimbursing or returning to the originating party the payment, merchandise, gift certificates, valuable consideration and awards in excess of the stated limitations. In such instances, written documentation of return must be submitted to the MHSAA for final determination of eligibility and forfeitures.

Member School Personnel:

Personnel of a member school (Associated Entity or Individual) violating this Section shall be subject to suspension which may be applied for any length of time based on the severity and circumstances of the violation as determined by the Executive Director, Executive Committee or Representative Council.

Member Schools:

Member schools in violation of this Section, by the actions of any Associated Entity or Associated Individual, shall be subject to suspension of membership status which may be applied for any length of time. A school's membership in the MHSAA and thus all the privileges of membership, may be revoked during a school year and or renewal of membership may be prohibited for any period of future years determined by the Executive Director, Executive Committee or Representative Council.

All allegations, investigations, violations, penalties and subsequent appeals of penalties shall be handled in accordance with the published Due Process Procedures as detailed on pages 19-21 of the *MHSAA Handbook*.
