Congratulations on advancing to the **2025-2026 MHSAA Lower Peninsula Tennis Finals**.

Here is a list of things you will need to know prior to arriving for this year's event:

- All matches will be played at the **Greater Midland Tennis Center (GMTC)**.
 - Day #1: All **SINGLS** matches **INDOORS** (courts #1 - #16)
All **DOUBLES** matches **OUTDOORS** (courts #17 - #20 & #25 - #35)
 - Day #2: ALL matches **OUTDOORS** (courts #17 - #20 & #25 - #35)
 - *These assignments are all dependent on weather.*
- **7:00AM - 8:00AM:** Coaches of teams/individual qualifiers may pick up their tournament packet at the GMTC the morning their specific Division Finals are scheduled to begin.
- **8:00AM:** Coach & players will gather in the west indoor courts (courts #11 - #16) for a brief meeting.
- **8:15AM: National Anthem**
- Play will begin at approximately **8:30AM**.
- MHSAA rules regarding team uniforms will be enforced throughout the tournament.
- Point penalty system will be enforced.
- Code violations from the Regional Tournament carry over into the State Tournament.

Warm-Up Courts:

- Day #1: Morning Warm-Up Courts – Tennis Center
- Warm-up courts at the Tennis Center will be assigned by the GMTC at **no cost to schools**.
 - *(assignments provided during the virtual meeting the TUE of your Final)*
- Teams will be limited to **2 courts for 30 minutes** on the morning of Day #1.

Trainers & AED:

- AEDs are available during the event while the competition is taking place.
- The AED will always be within site of the venue and accessible.
- A trainer or certified medical professional will be available during the event.
- If you feel that your team needs constant care of attention during the event, schools are encouraged to bring their own certified athletic trainer (ATC) or medical professional to cover their specific needs. Please inform the tournament manager if you are bringing a trainer or certified medical profession, and supply their name, contact information and credentials. If, during the coaches meeting, you are not informed of the location of the AED, please ask the tournament manager to share the location.

Coaches:

- Three (3) coaches are allowed for BOTH days of the event.
- Coaches must have completed all required elements to be eligible to coach in the post season.

Flights:

- Day #1: All SINGLES - Indoors (courts #1 - #16). All DOUBLES - Outdoors (courts #17 - #20 & #25 - #35)
- Day #2: All Flights - Outdoors (courts #17 - #20 & #25 - #35)
 - *assignments are weather dependent.*

Communication:

- We will use various ways to communicate match time and location.
- Coaches may be asked to sign up for “WhatsApp” to receive texts indicating match location.
- We are also working with **TennisReporting.com** to display court assignments on the TR.com brackets.

Virtual Coaches Meeting:

There will be a virtual coaches meeting conducted on **Tuesday (6:00 PM), the week of your finals.**

Coaches will be sent a link to attend the virtual meeting.

The meeting will cover some basic items such as **warm-up court assignments, first round court assignments** as well as other useful information.

There will still be a Player and Coach meeting on site to start your tournament at **8:00 AM.**

Virtual Meeting (GTN) Finals Week #2: TUE - June 2, 2026 (D2 & D3) **6:00 PM**

Parking:

- Parking is available in the tennis center's main parking lot.
- Tournament overflow parking lot (grass area) across Wackerly Street.
- All school buses **must** park in the tournament overflow parking lot.

Restrooms: Multiple bathrooms will be available in our facility.

Schedule (Tentative):

(DAY 1) Play all rounds up to and through the Quarterfinals:

- 7:00 am.....Warm-Up (*assignments provided during the virtual meeting the TUE of your Final*)
- 8:00 am.....Coach & Participant Meeting
- 8:15 am.....Team "March" followed by the National Anthem
- 8:30 am.....Round 1

(DAY 2) Semifinals & Finals

- 7:30 am.....Warm-up
- 8:30 am.....Semifinals
- AWARDS: To be conducted at the conclusion of all flight championships.

Seeding:

- "Area Seed" meetings are the SUNDAY following Regionals.
- The "Final Seed" meeting will take place after the "Area Seed" meetings.

Tournament Rules & Policies

- MHSAA uniform rules will be strictly enforced.
- The MHSAA point penalty system will be used.
- Code violations from Regional Tournaments carry over into the State Finals.

Additional Information:

- Team tents may be set up on the grassy hill on the east side of the courts, or on the pad outside of the pickleball area. **Please do not set up tents on the center walkway.**
- We ask that you do NOT bring coolers inside our facility, but you are welcome to keep them outside.
- We have a strict **no-dog policy** that will be enforced.

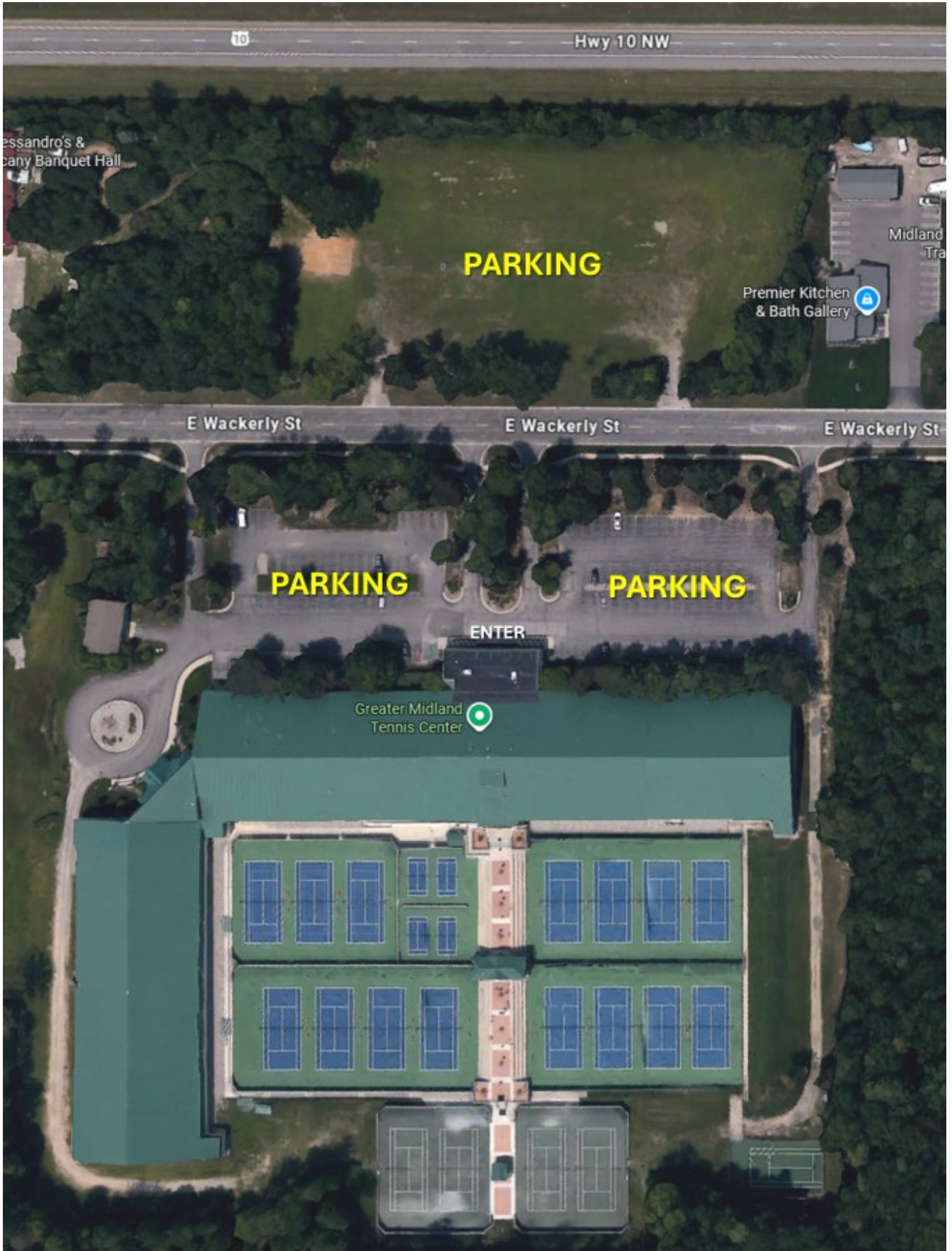

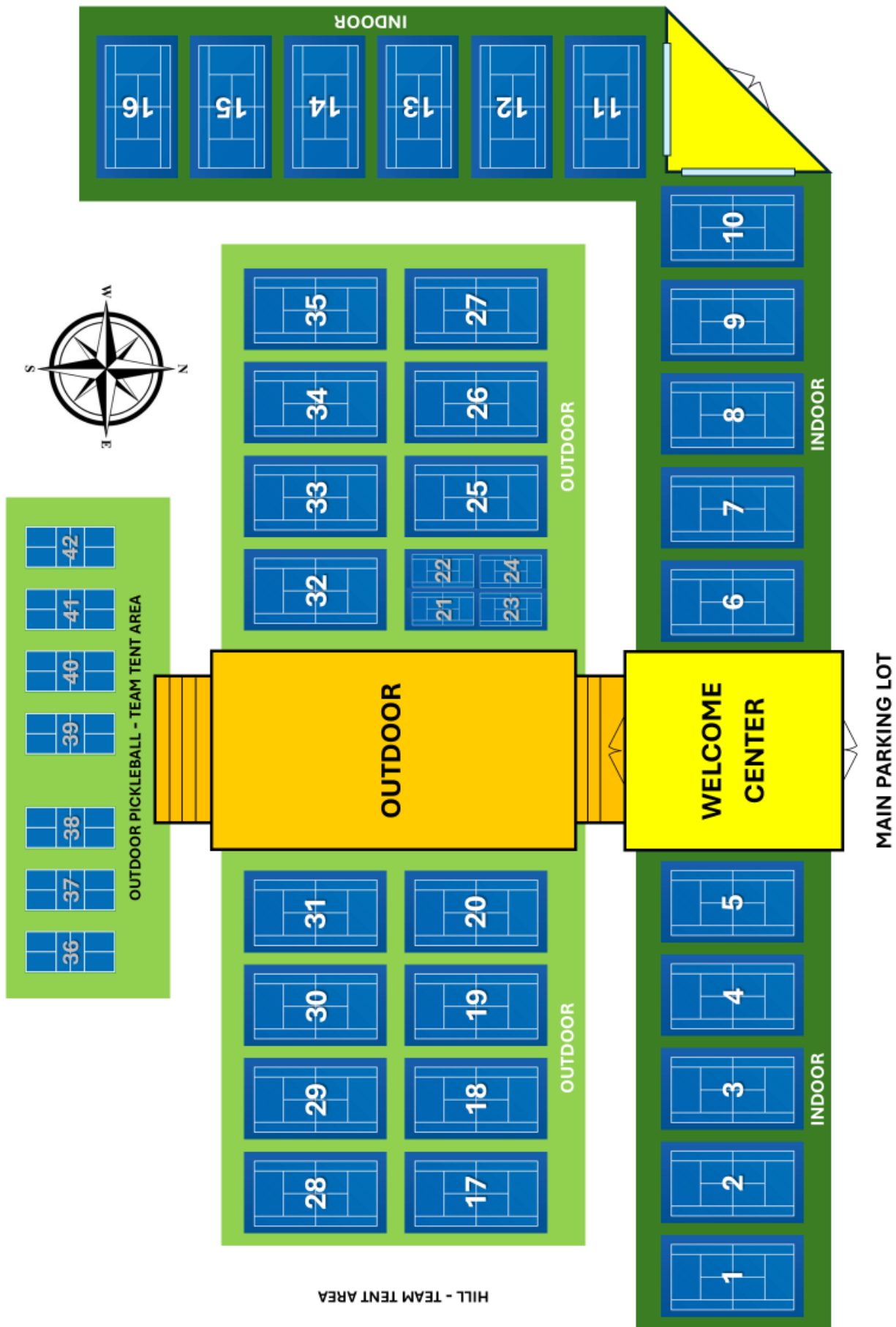
