ENTRIES:

We will be using ATHLETIC.NET.

1. FAT entries, please do NOT adjust times.

2. Hand timed entries should be rounded up and entered as 12.9 (i.e. 12.83 = 12.9). The coach does not need to add the 0.24 conversion factor, as athletic.net will add the 0.24 for the coach.

Entries are due on Tuesday, May 16 by 11:59 p.m.

SEEDING:

Seed sheets will NOT be mailed out to schools. Instead, initial seeding will be posted on the Bad Axe High School website (<u>www.badaxeps.org</u>). Click on High School Tab, click on MHSAA 2023 Regional Track Link by Noon on <u>Thursday, May 19</u>. The seeding sheets will be in PDF format and will require Adobe Acrobat Reader to view.

TEAM BUS PARKING:

Team buses should park in the Bad Axe Intermediate School Parking lot (north of the track). DO NOT PARK ON THE BUS LOOP AROUND THE FOOTBALL FIELD! Buses may drop off athletes at the west end, double gate, then proceed on to the intermediate school parking lot.

PARKING:

Spectators may park in the junior high parking lot on the south side of the junior high school.

<u>ADMISSION:</u> All tickets will be digital, sold via GoFan and cost \$7. A mobile device is required. Links for GoFan will be on each site hosts GoFan account found at www.GoFan.co

LOCKER ROOMS WILL NOT BE PROVIDED

TRACK MARKINGS:

Chalk may be used and will be provided. Please do not use any tape on the track!

IMPLEMENT WEIGH IN: This will be on-site before each flight competes.

PRESS BOX: No coaches, athletes or team personnel will be allowed in the press box at any time.

INFIELD/WARM-UP AREA:

No coaches are permitted on the infield at any time. Athletes may only be on the infield one event prior to their event for warm-up purposes. All athletes must enter the track at the west end gate.

TENTS/CANOPIES:

Set up of tents and canopies are permitted as long as they set up outside the competition area and are not on the infield.

SCRATCHES:

Scratches may be made in the scratch area underneath the Press Box. Scratches for Session 1 will be accepted from 7:45-9 a.m. and Session 2 from approximately 11:00 a.m. - Noon.

APPEALS:

The appeal process is intended to reverse the ruling or correct an error. In order to file an appeal, a coach must fill out the appeal form that will be included in the race day packet and give the appeal form to the meet monitor or meet manager.

The following situations are subject to appeal:

- 1. Misapplication of a rule
- 2. Clerical errors in placing (30 minute time limit)
- 3. Team scoring error (48 hour time limit)
- 4. Misapplication or failure to follow a procedure in the terms and conditions of competition announced in advance.

The following situations <u>ARE NOT</u> subject to appeal:

- 1. Judgment
- 2. Decision by finish judges/timers that does not involve misapplication of a rule

All appeals will be reviewed by the Jury of Appeals (one boys coach, one girls coach, meet monitor, and meet manager) and a decision will be made. The Jury of Appeals shall have the final authority over all appealed matters.

SPIKE SIZE:

All spikes must be 1/8 inch exposed or less.

RESULTS:

Results will be posted throughout the day on the kiosk located in front of the restroom wall/pegboard. Complete meet results and medals will be available for coaches approximately 15 minutes following the conclusion of the meet. The MHSAA will have results available online at mhsaa.com.
