ENTRIES:

We will be using Athletic.net. Entries are due on Tuesday, May 16, by 11:59 p.m.

Each school may enter 3 per event, but only two can compete unless they have met additional qualifying standards. Substitutions can only be made in relays. All times, distances, and heights shall have been achieved prior to the deadline. Times must be entered as FAT times to the hundredth (.00) or handheld equivalent as adjusted by Athletic.net (+0.24)

TEAM BUS PARKING:

Buses will park on the east end of the parking lot near the basketball hoops. Additional bus parking will be available at the <u>Dryden Township Offices</u>.

SPECTATOR PARKING:

Spectators may park in the high school parking lot. (3866 Rochester Rd, Dryden, MI 48428)

ADMISSION:

All tickets will be digital, sold via GoFan and cost \$7. A mobile device is required.

LOCKER ROOMS WILL NOT BE PROVIDED

TRACK MARKINGS:

Chalk may be used but will not be provided. No tape on the track.

IMPLEMENT WEIGH IN:

This will be on-site at the check-in table located by the High Jump

PRESS BOX:

No coaches, athletes or team personnel will be allowed in the press box at any time unless requested.

INFIELD/WARM-UP AREA:

No coaches are permitted on the infield at any time. Athletes may only be on the infield one event prior to their event for warm-up purposes. All athletes must enter the track at the west end gate by the concessions.

TENTS/CANOPIES:

Set up of tents and canopies is permitted as long as they are set up outside the competition area and are not on the infield.

SCRATCHES:

Scratches may be made in the scratch area where athletes are checking in.

APPEALS:

The appeal process is intended to reverse the ruling or correct an error. In order to file an appeal, a coach must fill out the appeal form that will be included in the race day packet and give the appeal form to the meet monitor or meet manager.

The following situations are subject to appeal:

- 1. Misapplication of a rule
- 2. Clerical errors in placing (30 minute time limit)
- 3. Team scoring error (48 hour time limit)

4. Misapplication or failure to follow a procedure in the terms and conditions of competition announced in advance.

The following situations ARE NOT subject to appeal:

- 1. Judgment
- 2. Decision by finish judges/timers that does not involve misapplication of a rule

All appeals will be reviewed by the Jury of Appeals (one boys coach, one girls coach, 2 meet officials other than the referee and starters, and meet manager) and a decision will be made. The Jury of Appeals shall have the final authority over all appealed matters.

SPIKE SIZE:

All spikes must be 1/8 inch exposed or less.

SCORING:

10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 in all events

RESULTS:

Results will be posted throughout the day on Athletic.net. Complete meet results and medals will be available for coaches approximately 30 minutes following the conclusion of the meet. The MHSAA will have results available online at mhsaa.com.

CONCESSIONS:

There will be a concession area open at the west end of the track.
