REPORTING:	Athletes must report to start by second call and if they are not on the line for their heat they will be scratched.
STARTING BLOCKS:	Schools are required to bring their own starting blocks.
SPIKES:	Pyramid spikes up to ¹ / ₄ " will be permitted.
AWARDS:	Medals will be awarded to the top four individuals/teams in each event.
BUS PARKING:	Buses may load and unload at the main track gate located at the northeast corner of the facility and park in the adjacent lot to that entry.
COACHES MEETING:	Will be held at 3:00 PM to review any and all concerns/changes.
CONTESTANTS:	UNIFORM RULES WILL BE ENFORCED.
