REGISTRATION: Athletic.net

ELIGIBILITY: CURRENT ELIGIBILITY MUST BE FAXED TO THE REGIONAL MANAGER WITH A HARD COPY, PRIOR TO THE DEADLINE. Cross-reference Electronic Entry with Eligibility list to ensure completeness and accuracy.

FALSE TIMES: All times, distances and heights shall have been achieved prior to 4 p.m. of the Opt-Out Due Date. Times must be entered as FAT times to the HUNDREDTH (.00) or handheld equivalent, adjusted by +.24. Confirmed false times will be placed in the last position or first section without seeding consideration.

FACILITY: * 8 lane, Metric, Polyurethane surface

* 1/8" spikes or flats may be used. 1/4" spikes may be used if the shoe has recessed sockets. Use the "2 Quarter Rule" when checking the length of exposed spikes. Don't risk your athletes getting disqualified. * Please bring your own chalk for marking exchange areas * CHALK MARKS shall be no bigger that 4" x 4" * PLEASE, NO TAPE on the track surface * Shot put and discus throwing surfaces are concrete

SCORING: 10 - 8 - 6 - 5 - 4 - 3 - 2 - 1

STARTING BLOCKS: Furnished by Milford High School. Schools may bring their own starting blocks as per the MHSAA Policy only.

SCHOOL CHECK-IN: Coaches must report to the concession stand room marked "Coaches Only" at the south end of the track to pick up their informational packets. Only athletes in uniform, plus 2 managers, will be admitted to the track with the team. **Athletes not in uniform will pay the full price of admission.**

IMPLEMENT CHECK-IN: Athletes will have their shots/discs certified in the shed at the **north** end of the field beyond the scoreboard beginning at 1:00 p.m..

COACHES' MEETING: 12:35 SHARP...at the concession stand for a short meeting regarding procedures and to answer any questions.

TIME SCHEDULE: A handy, one-page time schedule is attached as the last sheet of this information packet.

ORDER OF EVENTS: In all running events, the GIRLS will run FIRST (per MHSAA Track rules)

4 X 800 RELAY: The Girl's' relay will be the FIRST final running event of the day. It will be run no earlier that 3:30 P.M.

SCRATCHES: DEADLINE FOR FIRST SESSION SCRATCHES WILL BE 2:30 P.M. DEADLINE FOR SECOND SESSION SCRATCHES WILL BE 5:30 P.M. Because of the "enter 3, run 2" format on the entry list, you must scratch the athlete who is not participating. SHOULD ONE OF THE THREE ENTRIES NOT BE SCRATCHED DURING OR BEFORE THE SCRATCH PERIOD, THE CLERK OF COURSE WILL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO SCRATCH THE LAST LISTED INDIVIDUAL THAT HAS NOT MET THE ADDITIONAL QUALIFIER STANDARD. Athletes who are not scratched and fail to report to the clerk will be disqualified from that event with the event counting toward limits of participation.

WARM-UP AREA: An identified warm-up area will be available on the infield. There will also be a coaches box available on the infield.

ACCESS TO TRACK Access to the track from the stands will be via gates

BULLPEN AREA North and South ends of the straightaway. Athletes are NOT to jump the fence to gain access to the track. Athletes will be called to the bullpen area at the North end of the field, where heats will be set, then led to the track by the clerk. As an added convenience to athletes, a porta-john is located in the bullpen area at the north end of the field.

RESTRICTED AREAS Areas of the start/finish line and all areas nearest the field events are listed as restricted and off-limits to coaches. The PRESS BOX is also off-limits to coaches and athletes. **Field** event areas are off-limits and closed before and after the event unless.... The area is monitored by the event official or adult coach willing to assume responsibility for supervision of the area.

TRAINER: A certified trainer will be on duty throughout the meet. Please supply your own tape for ankles, etc.

POLE VAULT: BOYS: (AQ 13'3") START 1:00

Starting height will be 11'3". All raises will be 6" until the State qualifying standard (13"3") is met. This event will be run in rotation of "five alive".

GIRLS: (AQ 10'3") 45 minutes after completion of the girls' event. Starting height will be 8'3. All raises will be 6" until the State qualifying standard (10"3") is met. This event will be run in rotation of "five alive".

HIGH JUMP: GIRLS: (AQ 5'2") START 2:00

Starting height will be 4'8". All raises will be 2" until the State qualifying standard (5"2") is met.

BOYS: (AQ 6'2") 45 minutes after the conclusion of the boys' event. Starting height is 5'8". All raises will be 2" until the State qualifying standard (6"2") is met.

LONG JUMP: BOYS: (AQ 21'3") START 2:00

Preliminary jumps from 2:00 to 3:15. Open order for one hour and fifteen minutes or less. The top nine jumpers will advance to the finals ten minutes after the conclusion of the prelims.

GIRLS: (AQ 16'9") One hour after the conclusion of the girls' event. Open order for one hour and fifteen minutes with the top nine advancing to the finals.

SHOT PUT: GIRLS: (AQ 36'6") START 2:00

Event will be run in flights, (**best throwers LAST**) each flight taking two trials the first round and one trial in the second round. Top nine advance to the finals (best throwers last) 10 minutes after the finish of the preliminaries.

BOYS: (AQ 48'6") One hour after the conclusion of the boys' finals.

DISCUS: BOYS: (AQ 143'6") START 2:00

Event will be run in flights, (**best throwers LAST**) each flight taking two trials in the first round and one trial in the second round. Top nine advance to the finals (best throwers last) 10 minutes after the finish of the prelims.

GIRLS: (AQ 114'0") One hour after the conclusion of the girls' finals.

AWARDS: Coaches may pick up all awards won by athletes in the press box 10 minutes after the conclusion of the final event. Team trophies will be awarded on the track. **DO NOT go to the press box for awards before the conclusion of the meet.**

ADMISSION: \$7.00 for students and adults. NO PASSES ACCEPTED!

STATE QUALIFIERS: You may confirm state qualifiers at the press box following the presentation of awards after the meet.

PRESS BOX: For exclusive use of officials during the meet.

CONSTRUCTION AREAS: We have construction projects in progress right now in the stadium, those areas are secured with temp fencing. One of these projects is our visiting bleachers, so the visiting bleachers will not be accessible this year. Please stay away from these areas.

DRESSING FACILITIES: Please dress at home. There will not be any facilities available. The school is off-limits to athletes unless weather threatens.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: Local district policy will govern weather decisions. In the case of severe storms, shelter may be found in the hallways to the north, west and south of the field house. The entrance is located below the aluminum sculptures at the pool/field house doors.
