Entry Deadline:

Entry due date for electronic entries, in all Divisions is 11:59 p.m. on May 14, 2024 • A maximum of THREE INDIVIDUALS may be listed by a school for each bona fide team in EACH INDIVIDUAL EVENT at Lower Peninsula Regional Meets. Only two, however, may compete unless all three or more have met the additional qualifier (AQ) standard. AQ standards may be found on the MHSAA website.

All times, distances, and heights shall have been achieved prior to 11:59 p.m. on May 14. Times must be entered as FAT times to the hundredth (.00) and must represent true times. (No relay splits or estimates!)

Times must be entered as FAT times to the hundredth (.00) or handheld equivalent (e.g. 10.23 hand time is first rounded up to 10.3, then add .24=10.54 converted time) Entries for which times were not submitted or for which false times were submitted, are to be placed in the slow heat or without seeding consideration. All times must be from the current outdoor season, and if questioned, the entering coach must provide the date, location, and opponent when the time was achieved.

Entry Limitations:

One relay team per school team. A maximum of three individuals may be listed by a team in each individual event, no alternates, and no substitutions. **Only two may compete;** however, if three or more entries by a school team in an event have equaled or bettered the times or distances listed for the Division 2 Additional qualifying Times/Distances during the current outdoor season, then all these entries may enter and compete.

Additional Qualifiers:

If three or more entries by a school team in an event have equaled or bettered the times or distances listed for Division 2 Additional Qualifying Time/Distances during the current outdoor season, then all these entries may enter and compete in that event.

Call System:

To keep the meet running smoothly and efficiently the announcer will use the following system: First Call, second call, and third/final call. Athletes that have not reported by the third and final call will be scratched from that event, and it counts towards one of their four events.

Starting Blocks:

Traditional Starting Blocks will be provided, if you bring your own, they must be approved by the meet manager or meet referee.

Running Event Warm-Up:

The track will be available for warm-up until 1:45 pm and then again during the break between the semis and finals.

Field Event Warm-Up:

The Field event areas will be available for warm-up from 12:00-12:40 for the first session. Announcements will be made as each field event is completed so contestants will know the event is open for warm-up. One warm-up trail will be available between flights.

Awards/Results:

Results will be announced as soon as possible. Live results will be posted on Athletic.net. Team award packets will be available for pickup at the conclusion of the meet at the coaches' area.

Field Events:

All Field events expect high jump are located behind and east of the home bleachers.

High Jump: The five alive method will be used. Boys will jump first(even year) followed by the girls.

The pit is on the east end of the football field.

Long Jump: Open pit format will be used for both the semi-finals and the finals. We will conduct the

girls and boys long jump simultaneously on two pits.

Shot Put: Throws will be conducted going 1-1-1. All implements will be checked in and weighed at

the pavilion between the throws area. Boys shot will be first followed by the girls.

Discus: Throws will be conducted going 1-1-1. All implements will be checked in and weighed at

the pavilion between the throws area. Girls Disc will be first followed by the boys.

Pole Vault: Girls will vault first followed by the boys. All poles must be verified and inspected at the

event venue. This done by athlete, coach, and field event referee. All coaches must sign

the weight verification cards for their vaulters.

Track: The track is an eight lane track, only chalk may be used to mark handoffs.

Starting System: We will be using an electronic starting device.

Scoring: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 in all events
