- Scratches are due for the first session by <u>2:00p</u> (finish line computer operator).
- Scratches are due for the second session by <u>4:00p</u> (finish line computer operator).
- Scratch field event participants directly at the field event.
- Pole vault entry cards are mandatory and they must be signed by the head coach. They will be in your arrival packet.
- 1/4 inch or 1/8 inch spikes only.
- Shot / discus weigh-in at the white storage building from 12:30 to 1:30 pm.
- Track entry / exit gates are located at the middle of each turn. Athletes & coaches are to only use these two gates.
- Athletes will be allowed on the football field to warm-up. NO CAMPING ON THE FIELD. <u>Coaches will only be allowed on the field in designated coaches</u> <u>areas (the backstretch; high jump; long jump and pole vault)</u>. Coaches may NOT wander the football field.
- No open-air audio. No electronic devices inside the fenced track area or within the roped shot/discus field event areas.
- If you have a uniform question, ask an official.
- Live results will be available. The link will be posted around the stadium.
