Starting Heights:

<u>Shot put:</u> Competitors will receive 3 throws each. The top seven athletes advance to the finals to receive 3 additional throws. The places are determined by the farthest distance of all throws.

<u>Long Jump:</u> Competitors will receive 3 attempts each. The top seven athletes advance to the finals to receive 3 additional jumps. The places are determined by the farthest distance of all jumps.

GWINN HIGH SCHOOL GENERAL TRACK MEET INFORMATION

- 1. The National Federation "Track & Field Rules" will be followed.
- 2. The track is rubber, has six lanes and is 400 meters long.
- 3. Heat assignments will be made by the games committee.
- 4. Starting times will be adjusted according to the progress of the meet.
- 5. Field event information will be discussed and determined at the heat meeting. 6.

Pyramid spikes up to 1/4" in length are allowed.

- 7. Only timers and judges will be allowed near the finish line.
- 8. There will be no preliminary heats.
- 9. Shot puts are NOT to be thrown on the field (only in the designated area on practice field)
- 10. The 400 meter dash will be run in lanes for the entire race.
- 11. The 800 meter run, 1600 meter run, 3200 meter run will be run with a single waterfall stagger.
- 12. The 400 meter relay and 800 meter relay will be run in lanes for the entire race.
- 13. A three-turn stagger will be used in the 1600 meter relay..
- 14. A single-waterfall stagger will be used in the 3200 meter relay.
- 15. Visiting teams must provide their own starting blocks.
- 16. Please encourage your athletes to pick up garbage around their team area.
- 17. A concession stand will be available.
- 18. Live results will be available on athletic.net during the meet and final results will be posted after the meet.
- 19. Individual scoring: 8-6-4-2-1
- 20. Relay scoring: 8-6-4-2
 - 21. Awards: MHSAA championship trophies for the winning teams. Medals will be awarded for the top 5 places in individual events. Medals will be awarded for the top 4 places in relay events.
- 22. Scratch meeting: 2:00 p.m. (Eastern)
- 23. All discus and shot puts must be weighed by an official at the scratch meeting to be used in competition.
- 24. Entries due on athletic.net by Friday, May 24th at 9:00 p.m.
- 25. Athletes may participate in a maximum of 3 events.
- 26. Each school may enter a maximum of 3 athletes per event. The top 18 athletes for each event will qualify for this regional meet. Each school may enter 1 relay team for each event.
- 27. Jury of appeals: Meet manager, Gwinn boys' coach, Aspen Ridge girls' coach, and two meet officials.
