

SPECTATOR ADMISSION

- ★ Spectator Cost is \$7.00 per entrant, and tickets can be purchased on GO FAN Click Link.
- ★ Spectators will be only admitted at the Main Entrance of the Romeo HS Track and Field Facility.

ENTRIES

- ★ All entries need to be made on Athletic.net by 11:59 pm, Tuesday, May 13th, 2025.
- ★ Each team is allowed to enter 1 relay per team and 3 entries per event and must scratch down to 2 contestants. A team may enter more than 3 athletes, provided all athletes have met the regional additional qualifying standards. Teams not scratching down to 2 will have the lowest time/mark scratched if not meeting the AQ once the scratch window closes.
 - (Overrides will not be accepted, only confirmed times)
- ★ All performances shall have been achieved prior to 11:59 pm on May 14th, 2024.
 - Times must be entered as FAT to the hundredth (.00) or the handheld adjusted to the FAT
 - Handheld Times must be converted. The handheld times shall first be rounded up to the slower one tenth of a second (10.42 rounded to 10.5) then a conversion factor of .24 must be added (10.5 + .24 = 10.74).
- ★ Athletes or relay teams that do not have times submitted, or with incorrect times submitted, will be placed in the slow heat without seeding consideration. We will not reseed!
- ★ Please do not wait until the last minute to work on your entries. Late Entries for CLERICAL ERRORS ONLY. Start the process early. IF ENTRIES ARE LATE:
 - \$50 must be paid before the contestant or team will be allowed to participate. There are to be no late entries after the Regional individual positions are set.
 - The only changes which are permitted after 11:59 pm, May 14th, 2024 will be scratches or clerical errors so double check entries for accuracy.

ATHLETE CHECK-IN AND SCRATCHES

- ★ Scratches can be done with the meet timer at the finish line or directly online in Athletic.net. Please be prompt with scratches. Once scratched, the athlete cannot be added back in.
- ★ Athletes will check in with the clerk located at the 100, bullpen located in the northwest corner of the track (by the 100m start).
- ★ Call System: 1st, 2nd, 3rd (last) call will be used. Athletes should check in early and use a teammate or coach as a stand in if they are at a field event. Athletes will receive hip numbers for heat assignments at the event.
- ★ Athletes that do not check in will be listed as DNS and the event will count against their total.

AWARDS AND RESULTS

- ★ Scoring is 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 for places 1st 8th
- ★ Team awards packets may be picked up at the press box after the conclusion of the 4x400m relay.
- * Results will be posted to athletic net, and Live Results will be updated throughout the meet.

WARM UP AREA

- ★ Only athletes preparing for their event, and are checked in may use the northwest side of the track (closest to the entrance) for warming up. The Finish Line from the 30 yard line will be completely roped off. Athletes will not be allowed to enter this area unless leaving after finishing your race. Only coaches and checked in athletes should be on the infield.
- ★ Athletes must leave the competition and warm-up area once finished with their races. Coaches please help police this. Warm-up Cool-down areas for athletes not checked in include:
 - ★ Crushed Limestone Path Behind Romeo High School
 - ★ Soccer Fields @ Hevel Elementary
 - ★ Macomb Orchard Trail
 - ★ See (Warm-Up Facility Maps Link)

BARNABO FIELD TRACK

- ★ The track is an eight-lane Polyeutherine surface. Spikes that are no longer than 1/4" will be allowed. All exchange zones and waterfall markings have been updated and will be utilized per MHSAA guidelines.
- ★ Field Events are all in one area of the facility, located behind the visiting bleachers. We will be running 2 simultaneous pits of the Long Jump, separated by genders.

MARKING MATERIAL

- ★ Chalk is the only acceptable marking method and will be provided.
- ★ LJ and PV-chalk marks are to be on the outside of the runway lines. Runways are marked and a tape will be laid.
- ★ HJ-chalk marks are limited to 2 per athlete and no marks should be made near the takeoff area. Marks should be no more than 6' and identifying marks should be reasonable.
- ★ Relays-chalk marks should be reasonable in size and considerate of others who will be making marks after your heat. Absolutely NO TAPE...thank you in advance

CONCESSIONS/BATHROOMS

★ Concessions will be available throughout the meet and are located at the main entrance of the stadium. Bathrooms are also available in this area.

MHSAA RULES & MEET MANAGEMENT RULES TO BE AWARE OF

- ★ Air pods/headphones usage are not permitted in the competition area per MHSAA rules. Coaches, remind your athletes of this as officials will be policing this.
- ★ Removing shirts while in the competition area or changing in the competition area is prohibited. This is a point of emphasis, officials will be monitoring this. Remind your athletes.
- ★ Athletes not in competition (checked-in), are not permitted to be on the infield during competition.
- ★ Coaches permitted on the infield (wristband only), we have been instructed to not run back and forth point to point on the track. We don't plan to use coaches boxes on the infield, so please help us with this.

COACHES PASS/USE OF THE INFIELD

- ★ We want coaches to be able to have an opportunity to coach their athletes. There will be Coach's passes included in your packet, and we will be limiting this to 5 wristbands per school, which will grant coaches access to the infield, field event areas, and hospitality.
- ★ During the break, we will provide hospitality (food and beverages) to all coaches with a wristband in the RHS cafeteria.
- ★ Coaches, be mindful of the coned off areas so the timers and officials can do their jobs.
- ★ Coaches, remind athletes <u>NOT</u> in competition, that they need to leave the field, and spectate outside of the track/field areas. Athletes will only be considered in competition if they are checked in for their event, and are warming up. We need to keep the field mostly cleared throughout the day. Athletes can use the track for warm-ups during the break between prelims and finals.

SCHOOL DISMISSAL, BUS DROP-OFF, AND PARKING

- ★ Romeo H.S. dismisses @ 2:15 p.m., and will be still in session when Field Events begin.

 NO ATHLETES, SPECTATORS or COACHES should be going into the school throughout the school day. Thank you in advance.
- ★ Parking will be available while school is in session, but will be spread out prior to 2:00 p.m., so please plan accordingly. Click the Parking map link above for details.
 - Parking is available entirely around the school in the RHS lots, and behind the 9th grade academy. The 9th grade lot is virtually empty throughout the day.
 - Overflow grass parking and shoulder parking along Jewell Rd can be utilized if needed.
 - There's construction on our baseball fields during this time, so you will need to walk around the 9th grade center if using this lot.
- ★ ALL ATHLETES, COACHES, AND SPECTATORS...Parking between 2:00 p.m. 2:45 p.m. will be difficult during school dismissal. Please plan accordingly...be patient during this time as it will take longer.
 - We **STRONGLY** urge everyone to arrive before or after this time frame, if possible.
 - Inform athletes, coaches, and spectators about this time frame. If by chance you do arrive during this time due to events out of your control, the best lot to use will be behind the 9th grade center as dismissal buses and parents will be primarily in the main lot. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
- **★** Coaches inform your bus drivers
 - Buses dropping off prior to 2:00 p.m. can use our main bus loop, and then station at the closed Rite Aid on 29 mile & Van Dyke. <u>See Bus Parking Map</u>
 - The bus loop will be <u>CLOSED</u> to track and field buses starting at 2:15 p.m. due to RHS dismissal, and will re-open at 2:40 p.m.. All buses arriving prior to 2:00 p.m. will need to be stationed at the Rite Aid on 29 mile road until 2:45 p.m. after dropping athletes.
 - All lots will be open for School buses after 2:40 p.m.

ADAPTIVE EVENTS

MHSAA Regional and Final Track & Field tournament will include a wheelchair Track & Field category for wheelchair participants in four events. These events will include the 100m, 200m, 400m and shot put. Participants in this category must be eligible team members, meeting all MHSAA eligibility requirements and be listed on the school's Master Eligibility list. Participants in this category at a Regional meet must have participated in these events during TWO regular season meets. Please enter athletes under adaptive.

ATHLETIC TRAINER/MEDICAL ATTENTION

★ There will be a certified athletic trainer on site through the day (Kayla Bidus). Most of the meet she will be stationed at the start finish line. Don't hesitate to let us know if an athlete needs attention. Additionally, we will have water stationed throughout the west end of the track for athletes throughout the meet.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

★ When lightning is observed or thunder is heard, the contest must be suspended. When lightning is observed or thunder is heard and the contest is suspended, contestants shall not return to competition until lightning has been absent from the local sky and thunder has not been heard for 30 minutes. We have a contingency plan in place in case of severe weather.

JURY OF APPEALS

The Jury of Appeals shall consist of two meet officials (other than the Referee or Starter), the Meet Manager or their designee, one coach representing boys teams and one coach representing girls teams. The Jury of Appeals shall serve as the final authority. Any member of the Jury of Appeals who is a party to an appeal is not eligible to serve on the Jury for that appeal. The alternate selection shall replace them on the jury for that appeal. Judgment decisions may not be appealed.
