WARMUP: Will be allowed on the track before the start of the preliminaries and during the

break. Once races begin, no athletes or coaches should be on the in field unless

competing in or coaching an athlete in the high jump.

START HEIGHTS: Heights and raises for high jump and pole vault are available at the

MHSAA website under regional information for coaches.

SHOT/DISCUS: One concrete pad will be used for each event. Contestants will be placed in flights.

Three throws in prelims (2/1) plus three additional throws (2/1) for the <u>NINE</u> finalists. Tosses in prelims carry over to finals. Finals will be 15 minutes after prelims conclude.

LONG JUMP: 90 minute Mens open order jumping-men first, followed by women.

Three jumps for prelims and three additional jumps for NINE finalists.

Finalists are announced and finalists will have thirty minutes to complete jumps.

FINAL TIMING: Final placement in all races will be based on time when not in the same heat.

Fastest times determine place scoring.

ADVANCING ATHLETES FROM QUALIFYING ROUND TO FINALS -

Heat winners from each heat plus the fastest times fill all remaining available lanes.

• 2 Heats – 2 heat winners, 6 fastest times to fill available lanes

3 Heats – 3 heat winners, 5 fastest times to fill lanes
4 Heats – 4 heat winners, 4 fastest times to fill lanes

TENTS: May be set up in any area outside the four foot fence circling the track.

No loud music is allowed near the track or bleachers.

ENTRIES: All entries for regionals are done through athletic.net.

Additional regional information is available at the MHSAA website (mhsaa.com).

ENTRIES ARE DUE BY 8 PM TUESDAY, MAY 13, 2025.

Names will not be added after this point. You may enter three and scratch one up

until 3:30pm. If athlete not scratched-your lowest seed will be removed.

COACHES:

Once the meet begins, coaches are not allowed on the infield unless in coaching boxes. Questions or problems should be addressed to the meet referee who will be introduced at the coaches' meeting. Spectators are not allowed on the infield. Athletes not competing in the high jump will be asked to leave.
