<u>Infield Access</u> - Limited to meet personnel with appropriate passes and athletes participating in relay events. (No track spikes allowed on infield except those athletes crossing for relay purposes)

-Relay Event people can utilize the turf field 2 events before their scheduled relay. Prior to that the baseball outfield will be available

<u>Admission</u> - \$7 for all non-participating students and adults. League/Season passes are not accepted at MHSAA events

**ALL visitors will need to access the facility through the gates behind the homestand. There will be no spectator access by way of Clay Street gates.

<u>Warm-Ups:</u> The track (not infield) will be available for warm-up activity until 10:15 am. The track will also be available during the break between the preliminary events and 15 minutes before the start of the finals. (No sports drinks or food on the track or infield)

<u>Trainer:</u> An athletic trainer will be available and will be stationed in the end-zone area of the field near to the finish line.

<u>Team Parking</u> – Team buses/vans need to park at the Bus garage lot ACROSS from the track on the Clay Street side. (see map)

<u>Team Camps</u> – Team tents/gatherings may not be set up on the infield of the track. There are perimeter areas outside of the track that can be set up for teams. Each school will have a designated area. Remind teams to please pick up after themselves. Please keep any food brought to the meet to your school's designated Camp area. There will be plenty of trash receptacles set up throughout the campus. All high jump/long jump access will be through the gate nearest the woods by the pole vault area.

<u>Locker Rooms</u> – Showers/Lockers will not be available to participants. Athletes, however, may change/use restrooms in the locker rooms. (see map). Public restrooms are available at the pavilion behind the home grandstand and across the track on the backside of the fieldhouse (by the long jump pit)

<u>Security</u> – Remind all athletes to not leave bags unattended. New Buffalo Area Schools is not responsible for lost or stolen items

<u>Results</u> – will be available to coaches approximately 30 minutes after completion of the final event. The MHSAA will post results to its website by the Tuesday following the meet, provided that files are submitted electronically.
