Entries- We will be using ATHLETIC.NET
FAT entries only

Entries are due on **Tuesday, May 13 by 11:59 pm**. Each school may enter 2 per event

Coaches Meeting- 2:15 pm in the track shed

Team/Bus Parking- Schools will drop off in the football parking lot or track parking lot and then park their empty bus in the grass by backing in along the track lot. Parking lot attendants will help direct.

Spectator parking will be available in the track lot or football lot and along the roadside of the athletic complex.

Admission- All tickets will be digital, sold via GoFan. Links for tickets will be available at GoFan.com

Tents/Canopies- Team tents and canopies can be set up outside of the fenced in area, please do not block sidewalks. No tents/canopies are allowed inside the competition areas.

Track Marking- Chalk may be used and will be available. No tape allowed.

Infield Warm Up Area- No spectators allowed on the infield. We ask that athletes who are not actively competing or warming up stay out of the infield area. Coaches and athletes should be aware of the start area and exchange zone area and keep this space clear for view by officials. Please stay behind the flags.

Press Box- No coaches, athletes, spectators or team personnel in the press box. Please find Melissa Findlay for any needs from the press box.

Implement Weigh In/Pole Inspection- This will be done onsite in the track shed

Scratches- Scratches will be made on the scratch table in the track shed.

Spike size- All spikes must be ⅛ inch exposed or less

Results- Results will be posted on the bottom of the press box throughout the meet. Complete meet results will be available for coaches approximately 30 min after the conclusion of the meet. Results will also be available on ATHLETIC.NET

Appeals- The appeal process is intended to reverse the ruling or correct an error. In order to file an appeal, a coach must fill out an appeal form that will be included in the meet day packet and give the appeal form to the meet manager (Melissa Findlay).

The following situations are subject to appeal:

1. Misapplication of a rule
2. Clerical error in placing (30 min time limit)
3. Team scoring error (48 hour time limit)
4. Misapplication or failure to follow a procedure in the terms and conditions of competition announced in advance

The following situations are NOT subject to appeal:

1. Judgement
2. Decision by finish judges/timers that does not involve misapplication of a rule

All appeals will be reviewed by the Jury of Appeals (one boys coach, one girls coach, meet manager, and referee) and a decision will be made. The Jury of Appeals shall have the final authority over all appealed matters.

Concessions- Concessions will be available on site and there are also many local eateries within 1-2 miles of the athletic complex.
