Field Event Order: Girls: shot put, high jump

• Shot & Discus: after 3 preliminary throws with the top 7 athletes being called back for an additional 3 "finals" throws. The best distance of ALL throws will be their score.

- Long jump will be an open pit for preliminary jumps. The top 7 athletes will be called back for 3 additional "finals" jumps.
- Pole Vault/High Jump start heights will be determined at the coaches meeting

Scoring: 5 - 3 - 2 - 1
