- Field Event Order:** Girls: shot put, high jump
Boys: discus, pole vault, long jump
- Shot & Discus: after 3 preliminary throws with the top 7 athletes being called back for an additional 3 “finals” throws. The best distance of ALL throws will be their score.

- Long jump will be an open pit for preliminary jumps. The top 7 athletes will be called back for 3 additional “finals” jumps.
- Pole Vault/High Jump start heights will be determined at the coaches meeting

Scoring: 5 -3 -2 – 1

Merchandise: Official MHSAA merchandise will be sold at the event.

Team Parking: Team buses will park in the bus lot towards the north end of the school. Remind athletes to be cautious when crossing the parking lot. Please see the attached photo.

Admission: Tickets will be digital, through GoFan. All tickets are \$7.00. We will have a card reader at both the north and south entrances.

There will be a trophy presentation for the 1st place team at the conclusion of the final event, this will be for boys and girls
