Field Event Order:

Boys: Shot Put, High Jump, Long Jump (north end)
 Girls: Discus, Pole Vault, Long Jump (south end)

- Shot & Discus: after 3 preliminary throws with the top 7 athletes being called back for an additional 3 “finals” throws. The best distance of ALL throws will be their score.
- Long Jump will be open pit for preliminary jumps. The top 7 athletes will be called back for 3 additional “finals” jumps. The best jump of ALL jumps will be their score.
- Pole Vault/High Jump start heights will be determined at the coaches meeting.

- Scoring:** 5 – 3 – 2 – 1
- Merchandise:** Official MHSAA merchandise will be sold at the event.
- Team Parking:** Team buses will drop off athletes in the “bus driveway” and may park in this area during the event. Please do not arrive prior to 12:15 pm.
- Admission:** Tickets will be digital, through GoFan.co. All tickets are \$7.00. We will have a card reader at both entrances. No cash tickets will be sold.
- Team Camps:** Team “camps” must be set up outside of the track. Please remind your coaches/teams to remove trash from their area before leaving.
- Awards:** MSHAA medals will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place in both individual and relay events. Coaches will be able to pick up their packet of medals in the press box shortly after the conclusion of the final event. Those who medal will also advance to the UP Finals in Kingsford on Saturday, May 30th. There will be a trophy presentation for the 1st place team at the conclusion of the final event, this will be for boys and girls, and will be held on the track at mid-field.
