Teams are limited to 3 courts for 1 hour. Additional outdoor practice courts may be available at Midland High School or Dow High School.

<u>INDOOR COURTS</u> at the Tennis Center <u>cannot</u> be reserved for Thursday unless weather does not permit practice outside. There will be few to no indoor courts available on Thursday and we strongly encourage teams to practice at home before coming to Midland if it may rain. In the event you cannot practice outside, **please contact Mike** (mandrews@greatermidland.org) for indoor options when you arrive at the Tennis Center. Prevailing court rates will apply. Fees must be paid prior to getting the court assignment.

Free Outdoor and Indoor practice courts will be available for on Friday morning **BY RESERVATION**. Please email your request to me (mandrews@greatermidland.org). **No phone calls please**. Teams will be limited to two outdoor courts for thirty minutes; practice courts start at 7 am. Please indicate your time preferences. Individual qualifiers will be placed two to a court.

GENERAL INFORMATION

LOCATION OF PLAY – Friday all singles matches and #1 doubles will play outside at the Greater Midland Tennis Center. #2, #3, #4 doubles will play at Midland High School. Saturday all matches are outside at the Greater Midland Tennis Center.

<u>POINT PENALTY SYSTEM</u> – USTA rules will apply except where MHSAA rules supersede them. USTA-certified officials will be onsite throughout match play, and USTA Code of Conduct will be enforced. The Point Penalty System will be in effect.

TEAM UNIFORMS – Proper tennis attire is required. Please refer to the Team Uniform requirements mandated by MHSAA.

<u>PARKING</u> – There is plenty of parking available in the tennis center's main parking lot and in the tournament overflow parking lot across Wackerly Street. All school buses must park in the tournament overflow parking lot. Midland High has multiple parking lots; please park appropriately. **Any unattended parked cars that block fire hydrants, driveways or other cars will be towed at the owner's expense.**

TEAM TENTS & TAILGATE AREAS – Team tents can be set-up in the grass areas, but teams are encouraged NOT to set up outdoor tents until Friday morning, as there is no outdoor security. The tennis center is not responsible for items left outside unattended. Team tents may not be set-up on the middle cement walkway of the outdoor complex. **NO CROCKPOTS MAY BE PLUGGED IN!**

<u>USE OF INDOOR SPACE</u> – Indoor Space is only allowed if weather forces us inside. If play is moved inside due to weather, masks are required for all players that are not vaccinated per the MDHHS order. Masks are also required through the building for anyone who is not vaccinated.

TOURNAMENT DESK – Located at the back of main building, just outside.

<u>ADVANTAGE PRO SHOP</u> – Located on the lower level of main building, near the main entrance is a full service shop with stringing, racquets, shoes, clothing and accessories. PLEASE NOTE that personal stringing machines are **not** allowed inside the tennis center or in the outdoor complex.

<u>CONCESSIONS</u> – There are no concessions on site at Midland High School. The Greater Midland Tennis Center offers drinks and quick snacks for purchase at the Welcome Center.

<u>OTHER FOOD</u> – Prepared food can be brought into the tennis center in reasonable quantities.

NO COOKING OF ANY KIND ON TENNIS CENTER PROPERTY – NO GRILLS, CROCK POTS, HOT PLATES, ETC. We have a licensed kitchen and this is not allowed under our license.

OUTDOOR COURTS – Located straight through main lobby to back of building

TRAINER – There will not be a trainer on site. You are welcome to bring your own.

<u>VIDEO</u> – There is no videotaping of any kind permitted on the premises.

ANIMALS – Animals are not allowed at either facility.

SMOKING – The Greater Midland Tennis Center is a smoke-free property.

TRASH – You are responsible for your team's area! Help us keep our Facility and the School clean.
