- 1) Stadium location 63 Houseman Street NE, Grand Rapids, MI 49503
- Team parking Limited parking in lots immediately North and South of the Stadium. There will be team parking on both Houseman and Diamond Street, located at the West side (Houseman Street) and East side (Diamond Street) Parking pass must display on the dashboard.
- 3) Time Schedule:

Friday, 6/2/17 – Facility open for teams to inspect. The Track will be available for work outs. The Field Event venues will be closed, however you can mark steps if you so please. Tents can be set up in the designated areas, no guarantee that they will be there in the morning if a wind condition arises during the night. Vaulting poles can be inspected and stored overnight. - 6) Souvenir shirts will be available on the concourse located at the North West side of the Stadium. Also for sale on Friday, 4:00 to 7:00 pm on the Northwest deck by the clubhouse.
- 7) Only athletes in uniform allowed on the infield. All coaches must be in the stands for the running and in the designated areas for the Field Events.
- 8) Starting blocks will be provided. If you wish to supply your own blocks, you must have them approved by the Meet Manager or a Meet Referee/ Designee. You will be responsible for your blocks.
- 9) ¼" spikes only
- 10) Athletes should come dressed for competition as there are no locker facilities available.
- 11) Results will be posted on line at Michianatiming.com
- 12) Coaches can pick up packets at the Southwest entrance to the stadium on Friday from 4:00pm to 7:00 pm, or on Sat morning starting at 8:00am.
- 13) Formula for advancing from round 1 to the Finals for the races we are doing a first round will be First in each heat and the next fastest times as needed to fill the final heat.
- 14) Coaches must display their wrist bands to gain access to the field area. Wrist bands are necessary to gain access to the Field Event areas.
- 15) Please remind athletes of the requirements listed in Rule 4 Section 3 governing uniforms and specifically undergarments worn with the uniform.
