Different Paths to Dominance

One splashed onto the scene as a freshman. One was unknown at that age. In 2019, both dominated their races at the MHSAA Finals

Zofia Dudek wasn't on anyone's radar as a potential MHSAA champion cross country runner during her freshman year.

She not only wasn't running in Michigan, she wasn't running in the United States.

Dudek was in her homeland of Poland when she was in 9th grade after two years in Florida and one year in Indiana because of her father's job as a visiting professor of economics.

When Maciej Dudek was hired at the University of Michigan, Dudek enrolled at Ann Arbor Pioneer for her sophomore year.

From a school that has produced some of the top distance runners in Michigan history, Dudek may be the best of them all.

She won the 2019 MHSAA Lower Peninsula Division 1 championship with a time of 17:00.4, the fourth-fastest time by a girl at Michigan International Speedway. It was nearly a minute ahead of runner-up Arianne Olson, a freshman from Holland West Ottawa (17:53.0).

Dudek had the fastest time in the state last year, 16:46.9 in October, but the muddy conditions at MIS made it a tough day for chasing personal records.

"I was mostly just going for place and trying to do my best out there," Dudek said after leading the Pioneers to the team title as well, 33 points ahead of Traverse City Central.

Dudek proved to be a solid addition to the Pioneer team in 2017 when she placed 20th at MIS in 18:13.0. She improved to third the following year in 17:59.8.

"My sophomore year when I got 20th place, I thought that was amazing," Dudek said. "I thought I could never be one of the top five runners. It just feels amazing to be able to do this."

Unlike Dudek, Muskegon Western Michigan Christian's Abby VanderKooi made sure everyone knew her as a freshman, and then gave an even better performance last year.

Afterward, she wasn't being cocky. She was merely stating the obvious.

"I don't normally have competition anywhere, so it's really tough," the sophomore said.



Ann Arbor Pioneer's Zofia Dudek wouldn't have much company for long in the Division 1 meet, as she recorded the fourth-fastest time ever in MHSAA Girls Finals at MIS last fall.

Being one of the nation's top runners and competing in the smallest division at the MHSAA Lower Peninsula cross country championships only accentuates the gap between VanderKooi and her competition.

VanderKooi made the Division 4 girls race a battle for second place as she repeated as champion by 1:11.7 with a time of 18:11.0. In 2018, she won by a margin of 1:15.6 in 17:47.3.

So, how does VanderKooi maintain her focus in races when there is nobody else around to push her?

"I try to recite Bible verses, and that helps sometimes," she said. Her favorite, she said, is Philippians 4:13. "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." I like that one a lot."

In the team competition, Bridgman ended Mount Pleasant Sacred Heart's four-year run as champion by scoring 132 points. Sacred Heart was second with 148.

Karsyn Stewart was sixth overall and third among team runners in 19:38.8, while Arie Hackett was 11th overall and sixth among team runners in 19:58.2 to lead Bridgman.

Boys Division 1

Carter Solomon could finally relax, a luxury he couldn't afford himself for almost 3.1 miles. The Plymouth senior had the fastest time in the state last fall, but that didn't intimidate the other two runners who clung to Solomon in pursuit of the same dream, the 2019 Division 1 medal.

When Solomon had finally shaken his rivals and was in the clear, he thrust his arms in the air in a display of emotion he rarely showed while winning races all season.

He had finally checked off the final box on one of the best high school cross country careers in Michigan history, winning the championship in 15:01.2, the fastest time in any division in 2019.

"I think I came in as the favorite, but coming away with it still means a whole lot," Solomon said.

Solomon won a team championship with Plymouth in 2018, and placed in the top 18 all four years. The only boy to accomplish that feat in the MHSAA's largest classification since separate team and individual races were discontinued in 1996 was Rockford legend Dathan Ritzenhein, who made the top five four years in a row from 1997-2000.

Only two other boys have even been four-time all-staters in the top classification: Lake Orion's T.J. Carey (2009-12) and Brighton's Zach Stewart (2016-19).

Running stride for stride with Solomon for much of the race were Clarkston senior Brendan Favazza and Brighton senior Jack Spamer. Favazza finished second in 15:06.0, and Spamer was third in 15:17.1.

While Spamer was third in the battle for the individual championship, he got the prize that Solomon and his teammates won in 2018.

With Spamer in third and Stewart in fourth in 15:30.7, Brighton won its first MHSAA championship since 1995 and third overall by a 136-154 margin over Dexter.

Senior Scott Spaanstra was 31st in 16:05.4; sophomore Evan Ross took 46th in 16:17.6, and senior Andrew Hanna took 114th in 16:45.8 to complete Brighton's scoring.

It was the fourth MHSAA Final meet for Stewart and Spaanstra and the third for Spamer, but the other four Brighton runners were competing at MIS for the first time.

Division 2

Evan Bishop of East Grand Rapids had already established a reputation that stacked up favorably with anyone's in Michigan, but he didn't have an individual MHSAA championship on his resume.

That changed in 2019 when he won the Lower Peninsula Division 2 meet with a time of 15:12.6.

He defeated one of the runners who deprived him of getting an MHSAA championship sooner, Dearborn Divine Child senior Anthony Hancock, who was second in 15:18.2. Bishop was second in cross country in 2018 to Otsego senior Alex Comerford. In the spring of 2019, he took second to Hancock in the 3,200-meter run with a time of 9:08.03.

"If the weather would've been a little bit better, the extreme level of the field this year is just amazing," said Bishop. "Times could have been really fast."

When Hancock crossed the line, he immediately turned around to watch the battle for third place. He had a vested interest in the outcome because his twin brother, Michael, was battling Fremont's Nathan Walker. Michael Hancock edged Walker by two tenths of a second with a time of 15:23.7.

Walker did come away with the satisfaction of leading his team to a championship, as Fremont dominated the field with a 68-point performance. Otsego was second with 176. It was Fremont's eighth MHSAA title, the last coming in 2015.

On the girls side, East Grand Rapids swept the team and individual honors behind senior leader Anna Petr, who won a duel with Lansing Catholic senior and 2018 winner Jaden Theis. Petr ran down Theis to win in 17:59.6.

Including Theis, Petr finished behind 15 runners who returned to the Finals in 2019.



Hanover-Horton won the D3 team championship behind Garrett Melling, who was eighth overall and fifth among team runners.

"I wrote out all my goals at the beginning of the season and the steps I was going to take to get there," Petr said. "It's a little bit of a weird thing, but I found it really helps. I wrote like 'top five.' So, even that was a stretch."

Petr first saw herself as a potential Finals champion eight days earlier when she beat Theis in Regionals by 3.4 seconds.

Petr led another dominant performance by East Grand Rapids, which repeated as Division 2 champion by scoring 36 points. Petoskey was second with 91.

Division 3

It was 26 years since a 9th-grader from a high school in the northwest portion of Michigan's Lower Peninsula made MHSAA cross country history. Ryan Shay of Central Lake won the 1993 individual race at the Class D championships back when there were separate races for team and individual qualifiers.

Along came Hunter Jones in 2019, who joined Shay as the only freshman boy to win a race at an MHSAA Lower Peninsula Final when he ran away with the Division 3 title in 15:45.0.

Jones, whose school is 70 miles away from Central Lake, was aware of Shay's running legacy. Shay went on to win the NCAA 10,000-meter championship for Notre Dame in 2001 and claim five national road race titles. He died while racing in the U.S. Olympic marathon trials in New York on Nov. 3, 2007.

"That would be pretty awesome to be as good as him," Jones said.

Jones ran solo from the outset, winning by 28.9 seconds over Vandercook Lake senior Andrew Frohm.

Hanover-Horton won the team championship for the second time in three years, scoring 146 points. Grandville Calvin Christian edged Charlevoix, 183-184, for second place. Garrett Melling was eighth overall and fifth among team runners in 16:21.3, and Dean Reynolds was 10th overall and sixth among team runners in 16:27.6 to lead Hanover-Horton.

It was business as usual for the Hart girls, who won their third straight team crown by a 77-133 margin over Shepherd.

Hart put three runners in the top nine in the team race. Savannah Ackley was fourth overall and second among team runners in 18:49.0, followed by Audrianna Enns in fifth overall and third in the team race in 18:56.2. Lynae Ackley was 14th overall and ninth in the team race in 19:26.2.

Coming away with individual honors was Stockbridge sophomore Rylee Tolson, who emerged from a six-way battle for the championship.

She took the lead at the 2.5-mile mark of the 3.1-mile race and focused on her pre-race plan to maintain her lead over a hard-charging pack. She finished in 18:31.4, winning by 7.6 seconds over Maddy Bean of Richmond.

"It was scary," Tolson said. "I thought she was right behind me. I'm like, 'Oh, my goodness . . . Let's not focus on what's behind me; let's focus on what's in front of me.'"

Back to School: How We Got Here

Since March 12, our world has been anything but normal. These times have tested most everything in life, and as summer turned toward fall, we found ourselves still with far more questions than answers. It has been said that an abnormal reaction to an abnormal situation is normal behavior.

Let me start with these abnormal times. I had many conversations with administrators over the months leading to the start of school and school sports. The one constant theme was that these are anything but normal times. Many of these conversations moved to the issue of schools starting the academic year virtually while considering whether or not to offer school sports opportunities this fall. Let me share the things that have been part of almost all conversations on this topic.

The loudest message I heard was that kids were going to be playing sports this fall someplace. Period. Since May, that belief was proven consistently as athletic activity took place in the club, travel, AAU and non-school space nearly every day. From first-hand experience, many of these events implemented ZERO of the safety standards and protocols that businesses and schools had adopted for their plans of return. The non-school world generally plowed ahead this past summer with few-to-no rules, regulations, enforcement, oversight and accountability to anyone. If kids were to be playing sports, our member schools told us that activity needs to be in the safest environment possible – which is with professional educators and trained coaches in our school sports world.

Schools were quick to point out that kids had been conditioning and training with school coaches in school-sponsored workouts most of the summer. We believed that the absence of virus outbreaks among our 749 high schools' summer activities, involving thousands of kids, was because schools were following the return-to-activity plans. Districts told us they can continue doing what they've been doing safely since June by following all COVID guidance and regulations that the MHSAA put in place with government's leadership and partnership.

Schools starting the year virtually have told us they used the lessons learned from the start of sports for when students eventually returned, or will return, later this year. School administrators have shared this view privately as this has become a highly-charged topic among various groups within our school communities. Sports allow schools to bring students back to campus in small, consistent and defined groups with the same adults working with those students each day. In school sports, there is little mixing of students from one sport with those students in another – making it much easier to monitor, track and trace kids when needed than if all students were in the buildings, hallways and classrooms all day. We heard from administrators that valuable lessons learned with athletics in August and September could lead to a more successful school start-up with students back on campus later in the year.



All of us share the fundamental belief that we must protect the health and safety of individuals first. This doesn't include only COVID prevention measures, but also the mental health of teenage students and adults as well. In districts starting the school year online, they viewed athletics being the one shred of normalcy students, and staff members who choose to coach, would have during the fall. It's a chance to safely interact with peers and get needed physical activity that hasn't been happening for some kids since March. Health and safety has to include all facets of the individual, and more research is being shared each day about how mental health is becoming a critical issue during these times. For many at-risk kids, sports is the one motivating factor to keep them in school and progressing toward graduation. Given the challenges of all online education for these at-risk kids, sports and the daily routine they bring perhaps are more important for this group of students than ever before.

With no school sports, the affluent communities and families can navigate online learning during the day and then afford the non-school athletic opportunities that kids and families in less-affluent areas simply cannot. In many communities, school sports can provide opportunities and open doors that would not appear if kids become priced-out from participating and competing.

The past several months have been the most abnormal in a century. School sports being the one pathway back to school for students in our state – the one norm for this year – run by professional educators who put kids first, can be an incredible boost to the physical and mental health of all of us. We believe that school sports can be done safely and smartly, and the MHSAA continues to develop plans that do just that. We believe we must react to these abnormal times by thinking differently and looking at these unique times through a unique lens.

Trying to find one normal for our kids in these abnormal school days might just be the best thing we can do.

“It is amazing to see the number of young people who are proven achievers in academics and activities,” said Mark Uyl, executive director of the MHSAA. “At a time when our educational system is coming under fire, the Scholar-Athlete

Award is something that proves how important athletics are to the development of a well-rounded person.”

Students applying for the Scholar-Athlete Award must be graduating during the 2020-21 school year, carry a 3.5



grade-point average, and have previously won a letter in a varsity sport that the MHSAA sponsors postseason competition.

Applicants will also be required to show involvement in other school-community activities and submit an essay on the importance of sportsmanship in educational athletics.

Each MHSAA member school is allowed to nominate a number of student-athletes based on the size of the school. Class A schools can nominate six boys and six girls, Class B four boys and four girls, Class C three boys and three girls and Class D two boys and two girls. The first 30 scholarships will be awarded based on this graduated scale, with two additional scholarships intended for minority applicants.

A committee composed of school administrators from across the state will select regional and statewide winners.

Farm Bureau Insurance, a long-time supporter of MHSAA activities, also sponsors other educationally oriented programs. Chief Executive Officer Don Simon notes the company's pleasure with the awards program.

The 32 scholarship recipients will be recognized at the MHSAA Boys Basketball Finals at the Breslin Student Events Center in East Lansing in March.

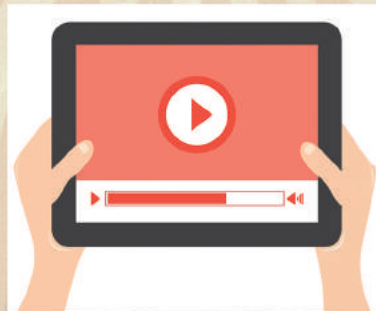

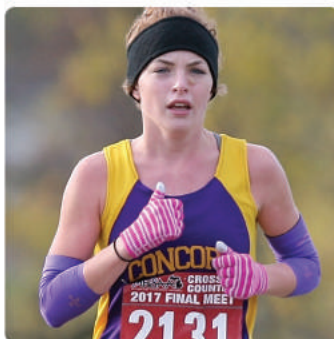
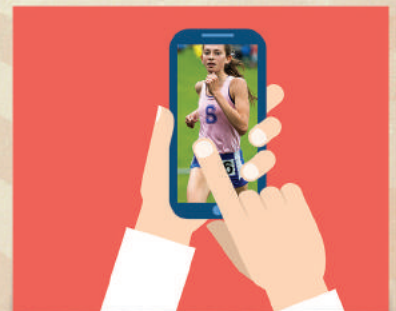

Student Advisory Council Aids MHSAA

The Student Advisory Council is a 16-member group which provides feedback on issues impacting educational athletics from a student's perspective, and also is involved in the operation of Association championship events and other programming. Members of the Student Advisory Council serve for two years, beginning as juniors. Eight new members are selected annually to serve on the SAC, with nominations made by MHSAA member schools. The incoming juniors join the group of eight seniors-to-be appointed a year earlier.

Those eight new members were selected from a record-high 179 applicants, twice as many as generally apply for SAC positions every year.

With the addition of this class beginning this summer, members will have represented 117 schools from 45 leagues plus independent schools that do not play in a league. Combined, the new appointees have participated in nine MHSAA sports, and seven will be the first SAC members from their respective schools.

The MHSAA Representative Council

The Representative Council of the Michigan High School Athletic Association is the body assembled to carry out the wishes of member schools. The Council meets several times annually to discuss and pass legislation concerning interscholastic athletics in Michigan.

The Representative Council is made up of 19 members, with all but five elected by a vote of MHSAA-member schools to represent different geographic regions, different sizes of schools, nonpublic schools, and junior and middle schools. Two members are elected to statewide at-large positions. Four members are appointed by the Council to facilitate representation of females and minorities, and the 19th position is occupied by the Superintendent of Public Instruction or his/her designee.

The officers and two other representatives form the MHSAA's Executive Committee, which meets on a monthly basis during the school year to review eligibility appeals and other current business.
