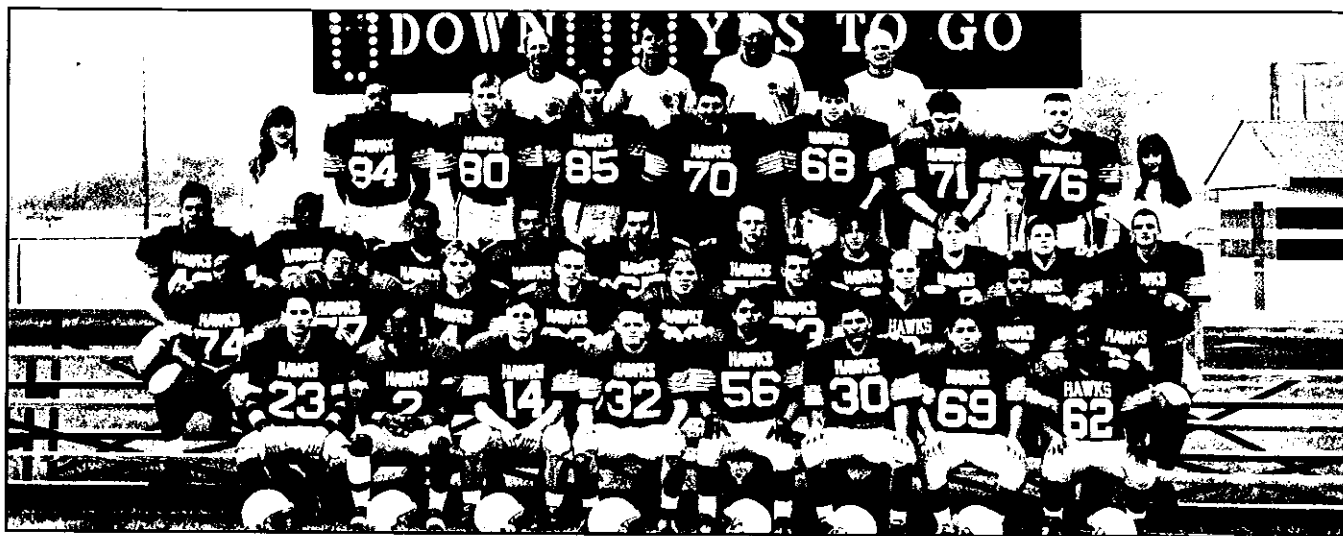

FINAL GAME NOTES — Harrison made use of the big play to claim its second straight Class A crown and seventh title overall in nine final game appearances. Williams' 90-yard run to open the second quarter established a new all-class finals record for longest run from scrimmage, and the 80-yarder from Granger to open the third period was the third longest run in finals history. A footnote on the one-play drive on Williams' TD — an offsides penalty on Harrison was called prior to the scoring play, making the drive an 85-yarder, even though the scoring play was 90 yards.
